ORDINANCE NO. _____

Amending Multnomah County Code Chapter 25 – Non-Departmental - Concerning the Organization and Functions of the Joint Office of Homeless Services and Declaring an Emergency.

Multnomah County Ordains as Follows:

Section 1. MCC § 25.710 – Joint Office of Homeless Service is added as follows:

§ 25.710 – JOINT OFFICE OF HOMELESS SERVICES.

§ 25.710- Office Established.

A Multnomah County Joint Office of Homeless Services is established. The Office shall be responsible to procure and administer contracts for direct services to single adults, families, youth and victims of domestic violence in need of housing support. The Director of the Office is appointed by the Chair and reports directly to the Chair.

§ 25.720- Duties.

The Director will:

- (A) Administer all aspects of the Joint Office of Homeless Services;
- (B) Advise the Board of County Commissioners and the Portland City Council on matters of concern to the Joint Office;
- (C) Manage Joint Office staff, budget and compliance; and
- (D) Convene the Policy & Budget Alignment Committee (PBAC) established by Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Portland.

Section 2. This ordinance being necessary for the health, safety, and general welfare of the people of Multnomah County and the City of Portland, an emergency is declared and the ordinance takes effect upon its signature by the County Chair.
