## Wheeler campaign soaring as Hales bails from mayor's race

*Some say election no slam dunk, valid foe may emerge*

The morning Charlie Hales dropped out of the Portland

mayor's race, Ted Wheeler had breakfast at the Heathman Hotel with influential neighborhood leader Robert McCullough.


The meeting was both coincidental and symbolic. Wheeler, the state treasurer, now seems a shoo-in to replace Hales. And McCullough, the chair of the Eastmoreland Neighborhood As-

sociation and president of the Southeast Uplift neighborhood coalition board, has been one of the mayor's most outspoken critics. He repeatedly has faulted the mayor for not moving fast

enough to stop residential demolitions. He also has challenged the lack of public process for moving the Right 2 Dream Too homeless camp to Southeast


Portland, and he led a court fight to obtain internal city records on the failed street fee proposed by Hales and Commissioner Steve Novick.

"Although I personally like Charlie, I am pleased that Ted is likely to be our next mayor. In many ways, the city staff have
