

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
FOR THE COUNTY OF MULTNOMAH  
ORDINANCE NO. 632

An ordinance creating the Multnomah County Youth Services Commission, making appointments, and declaring an emergency.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Title.

This ordinance shall be known as the Multnomah County Youth Services Commission Ordinance.

Section 2. Findings.

1. The Oregon Legislature has created a new Oregon Youth Services Commission by the passage of House Bill No. 3466, which amends ORS 417.445.

2. These legislative changes require counties planning to receive funds for comprehensive juvenile services, Great Start and Student Retention Initiative Plans, to appoint a local children and youth services commission consolidating these programs in one agency.

1           3. The new Youth Services Commission, as required by  
2 statute, will replace the existing Juvenile Services Commission,  
3 Student Retention Initiative and Great Start Plans in Multnomah  
4 County. To avoid an unnecessary interruption in the provision  
5 of existing and future services, an emergency is hereby declared.

8 is declared and the Ordinance shall take effect upon its  
9 execution by the County Chair, pursuant to Section 5.50 of the  
10 Charter of Multnomah County.
