General Information

1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

Approval of an IGA with the Oregon Department of Transportation.

2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results.

The Bridge Division of the Department of Community Services plans to begin development of plans and specifications for the Broadway Bridge Phase 7b Painting project upon approval of this IGA, and project construction will begin in 2014. The IGA will provide funding to remove existing lead paint from the Broadway Bridge and apply a new paint system to the portion of spans 2, 3, and 7, which are above the roadway deck, including the sidewalk handrails. The portions of the bridge below the roadway deck on all spans and the portions of the bridge above the roadway deck on spans 4, 5, and 6, were painted during the Broadway Bridge Phases 4, 5, 6, and 7a Project in 2003.

3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing).

The IGA will provide funding for the \$10,500,000 Broadway Phase 7b paint project. \$9,421,640 will come from federal funds, and \$1,578,360 will be County matching funds from the Bridge Division budget.

4. Explain any legal and/or policy issues involved.

This project may cause disruption to streetcar operations on the Broadway Bridge during the painting. The City and County have an IGA that covers the disruption to the streetcar service during the painting project. The County will work with the City to minimize the disruption as much as possible.

5. Explain any citizen and/or other government participation that has or will take place.

This project is on the County Transportation Capital Improvement Plan, which has been presented at various public meetings.
