ORDINANCE No. 143

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 134; correcting a typographical error; requiring reports of claims for loss of personal property and entry of judgments and decrees; requiring proof of satisfaction of judgments and decrees; and declaring an emergency.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 12 A. 10. of Ordinance No. 134 is amended to read:

"10. Not change an approved location or establish a location without first obtaining an amended license pursuant to Section 11 of this Ordinance."

Section 2. Amendment. Section 12 A. is further amended by adding thereto the following subsections:

"11. Report to the Director, on a form to be provided by the Director, within 48 hours of the receipt thereof any claim or complaint of loss or disappearance of personal property occurring during the course of transportation in a vehicle.

"12. Report to the Director, on a form to be provided by the Director, within 10 days from the entry thereof any final judgment or decree entered against it, or any of its employees, relating to the loss or disappearance of personal property occurring during the course of transportation in a vehicle.

"13. Furnish proof satisfactory to the Director within 60 days of the entry thereof of the satisfaction or performance of any judgment or decree subject to subsection (12) of this section."

Section 3. Emergency Clause. This Ordinance being necessary to correct a provision of Ordinance No. 134 and to provide protection for persons transported in vehicles subject to Ordinance No. 134, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption.

ADOPTED this 31st day of March, 1977, being the date of its first reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.
