Proclaiming September 2014 National Recovery Month in Multnomah County, Oregon.

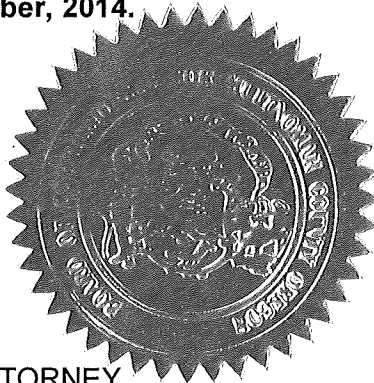
The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. For 25 years National Recovery Month has worked to raise awareness for people who are currently attempting to overcome their mental health/substance abuse disorder through treatment.
- b. Substance use and mental health disorders are major public health problems affecting Oregonians of every age, race and ethnic background in all communities. With appropriate treatment and ongoing support people with these disorders can achieve healthy lifestyles and lead rewarding lives in recovery.
- c. In 2012, 2.5 million people age 12 or older received specialty treatment for substance use disorders and more than 34.1 million adults aged 18 or older received services for mental disorders, according the 2012 National Survey on Drug Use and Health (NSDUH). According to a 2009-2010 survey by the same organization, Oregon was in the highest fifth of states across the US for use of illicit drugs by persons aged 12 or older. Given the serious nature of this public health problem, we must continue to reach the millions more who need help.
- d. Real stories of long-term recovery can inspire others to ask for help and improve their own lives and the lives of their families and thus the entire community. It is critical that we educate community members that substance use and mental health disorders are serious yet treatable health care problems, and by treating them like other chronic diseases, we improve the health of the entire community.
- e. Through education, prevention and treatment we can improve the quality of life for the entire community. We must encourage relatives and families of people with mental and/or substance use disorders to recognize the signs of a problem and guide those in need to appropriate treatment and recovery support services.


The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Proclaims:


