Exempting from the Formal Competitive Bid Process a Contract for the Purchase of the External Security Services for the Mead Building from Portland Downtown Services, Inc. for a three (3) year period.

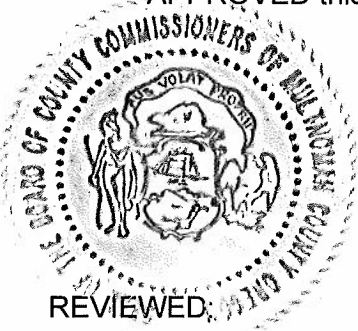
The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. The Board, acting in its capacity as the Multnomah County Public Contract Review Board to review, pursuant to PCRB Rules 10.140 a request from the Department of Community Justice for an exemption from the formal competitive Bid process to contract for the purchase of external security service for the Mead Building from Portland Downtown Services, Inc. for a three (3) year period. The amount of the contract for the first six (6) month period is \$48,033.
- b. As it appears in the staff report from Franna Hathaway and the memorandum from Elyse Clawson, the request for exemption is based upon the fact that the County entered into a Good Neighbor Partnership Agreement with the Association for Portland Progress which includes the provision that the County will contract with Portland Downtown Services, Inc., a subsidiary of the Association for Portland Progress, to provide external security services for the Mead Building.
- c. This exemption request is in accord with the requirements of Multnomah County Public Contract Review Board Administrative Rules 10.140.


The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners, acting as the Public Contract Review Board Orders:
