The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:


- a. Commissioner Sharron Kelley has served the people of Multnomah County with distinction for eleven years.

- h. This unwavering ability to follow her heart has made a positive and profound impact on the lives of the most vulnerable citizens of Multnomah County.


The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Proclaims:
