

In the Matter of a Sole Source
Exemption to Purchase a Micro-Imager
and Mainframe system from Eastman
Kodak Company.

The above entitled matter is before the Board of County Commissioners, acting in its capacity as the Multnomah County Public Contract Review Board, to review, pursuant to ORS 279.015 and AR 10.100 and 20.030, a sole source exemption, requested by the Sheriff's Office, to purchase a micro-imager and mainframe system from the Eastman Kodak Company at an estimated cost of \$77,000.

It appearing to the Board that the recommendation for exemption, as it appears in the application, is based upon the fact that the Eastman Kodak Company is the sole manufacturer of equipment which features "multi-plexor". This feature eliminates the need for dedicated circuits for each piece of equipment. This feature will represent a cost savings to the Sheriff's Office in its installation of a paperless filing system.

IT IS ORDERED that the purchase of the micro-imager and mainframe system from Eastman Kodak Company be exempted from the requirement of public bidding.
