Auditors ask several key questions in every audit:

- What happened?
  - Includes trends in revenues, expenditures, and financial health indicators for the County
- Why did it happen?
  - Includes indicators for the County's revenue base and economy.
- So What?
  - Some of the so what includes demographic trends such as population and poverty indicators, but also an evaluation of how the indicators affect or reflect the others.
- What needs to be changed (recommendations)?
  - County has implemented the few recommendations we have made over the years of our issuing this report.
