Appointment of Glen Tyrell as new member to the Citizen Involvement Committee. If appointed, he will serve a three-year term, effective through October of 2017.

These include geographic distribution, a letter of recommendation, interviews with current committee members and staff, and participation at CIC discussions, events and meetings.
