CAP's Impact 2013



- 35,000 total people reached
- 12,000 people reached via outreach efforts
- Distributed over 380,000 condoms and safer sex supplies
- 4,026 HIV/STD tests administered
- 2,292 people received housing, emergency assistance or life skills training




