WHEREAS, Multnomah County is proud and pleased to recommend the Great Blue Heron as a symbol of such efforts made on behalf of wildlife throughout the metropolitan area; and

WHEREAS, the metropolitan region is now working with the support of the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service to restore critically important wildlife habitat areas; and


WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Greenspaces Program, which enjoys regionwide support, seeks to produce a comprehensive strategy for the long-term protection of wild lands and wildlife habitat in the metropolitan region; and




