The Columbia Slough Watershed Council is a community based tax-exempt non-profit formed as part of the State of Oregon-Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board's salmon recovery efforts. They work in Gresham, Fairview, Northeast and North Portland to educate youth and adults, provide outdoor recreation, and engage in water and land restoration all to protect and enhance the watershed.

The Council is funded through the Watershed Enhancement Board, foundation and government grants, corporations, individual donations, contracts, program-earned income, and fundraising events.

According to Oregon law (ORS 541), watershed councils are designated by a local government group convened by a county governing body to address natural resources and watershed protection. The Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board requests that watershed councils report to their county governing body on a regular basis.
