ORDINANCE NO. 48

An Ordinance establishing an Office of Probation and Parole within the Department of Judicial Administration.

WHEREAS, an Office of Probation and Parole should be established within the government of Multnomah County to provide various correctional and related services to the courts of Multnomah County; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Chapter 633, Oregon Laws 1971, the responsibilities and functions of the City of Portland Probation and Parole Office will cease as of January 1, 1972, and such office personnel thereof, its records and pending cases should be integrated into the County government as a transferred office.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. There is established within the Department of Judicial Administration the Office of Probation and Parole to provide correctional and related services to the courts of Multnomah County and such other public agencies with whom the Board may see fit to contract.

Section 2. The present personnel of the City of Portland Office of Probation and Parole, including its Director, shall be accepted into the Office of Probation and Parole created by this Ordinance as transferred employees to serve under the Director of the Department of Judicial Administration, with all the rights and privileges afforded them by the provisions of ORS 236.610 - ORS 236.650, including Civil Service status.

Section 3. The Director of the Department of Judicial Administration is authorized to establish reasonable rules and regulations for the purpose of carrying out the functions and responsibilities of the Office of Probation and Parole to the courts.

Section 4. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage.
