

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

FOR THE COUNTY OF MULTNOMAH

ORDINANCE NO. 553

An Ordinance requesting that the Assistant Director for Health of the State of Oregon delegate authority to the Board of County Commissioners for certain health laws and directing the Board to establish fees.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

SECTION I. Findings.

1. ORS 448.100 provides that the State Assistant Director for Health may, upon request of the County, delegate authority to the Board of County Commissioners.
2. Multnomah County has previously requested and been granted the authority to carry out the rules of the Health Division relating to fee collection, licensing, inspection, enforcement, and issuance and revocation of licenses for restaurants, swimming pools and spas.
3. Multnomah County is now willing and able to carry out the rules of the State Health Division relating to review of plans for construction of swimming pools and spas and agrees to abide by these rules.

SECTION II. Request for Delegation of Authority.

1. Multnomah County requests the Assistant Director for Health of the State of Oregon to delegate to the Board of County Commissioners all authority, responsibility and functions of the Health Division relating to plan review for construction of spas and swimming pools and setting fees for such review.

This Ordinance, being necessary for the health, safety, and general welfare of the people of Multnomah County, the Ordinance shall take effect on the thirtieth (30th) day after its adoption, pursuant to Section 5.50 of the Charter of Multnomah County.

ADOPTED this 21st day of May, 1987, being the date of its second reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County.
