

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR
MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON
ORDINANCE NO. 152

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 124 by substituting Health Officer for Director of the Division of Health Services; prohibiting employment of food handlers in public eating places without certificates; establishing expiration period for certificates; and increasing fees.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Ordinance No. 124 is amended as follows:

Section 1. Amendment. "Health Officer" is hereby substituted for the term "Director of the Division of Health Services" where said language is contained therein.

Section 2. Amendment. Section 2. of Ordinance No. 124 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. Prohibition.

A. No owner of a public eating place shall hire an employee without the employee having a valid food handler's certificate.

B. No person shall perform work as a food handler without having first procured a food handler's certificate.

Section 3. Amendment. Section 3.A. of Ordinance No. 124 is amended by substituting "Division of Epidemiology and Health Sanitation" for "Division of Health Services."

Section 4. Amendment. Section 4. Fee. of Ordinance No. 124 is amended to increase to \$3.00 the \$2.00 fee.

Section 5. Amendment. Section 10. Grace Period is hereby deleted and there is substituted for Section 6. a new

section hereinafter set forth, and all subsequent sections are correspondingly renumbered as hereinafter provided:

"Section 6. Expiration.

A food handler's certificate shall expire three (3) years from date of issuance."

Section 6. Compulsory Physical Examination is redesignated Section 7.; Section 7. False Statement is redesignated Section 8.; Section 8. Other Violations is redesignated Section 9.; Section 9. Form of Certificate is redesignated Section 10.

ADOPTED this 1st day of December, 1977, being the date of its second reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.


