ORDINANCE NO. 91

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 15, as amended by Ordinance No. 90, revising dog license fees, and declaring an emergency.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1, Ordinance No. 15, as amended by Ordinance No. 90, is further amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. A license fee for each spayed female or neutered male dog for which a veterinarian's certificate of operation for the spaying or neutering of the dog is presented under the provisions of ORS 609.100 shall be \$5.00 annually, effective January 1, 1975. The license fee for all other dogs licensed thereunder shall be \$10.00 annually, effective January 1, 1975, except that any person over 65 years of age, certified by an aging program, shall be entitled to a \$5.00 reduction for one dog for the current year. A penalty of \$5.00 shall be charged for any such license fee not received prior to March 2 of each year."

Section 2. Adoption. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage pursuant to Section 5.50 of the Charter of Multnomah County.

ADOPTED this 30th day of January, 1975, being the date of its 1st reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.
