**ORDER**  
#88-126

The above entitled matter is before the Board of County Commissioners, acting in its capacity as the Multnomah County Public Contract Review Board, to review, pursuant to AR 10.110, a declaration of emergency for the conversion of street lighting from overhead to underground on S.E. 257th Street from Cherry Park Road to Columbia Street by Portland General Electric Company and General Telephone of the Northwest at a total cost of \$6,670.05.

It appearing to the Board that the declaration of emergency, as it appears in this order, is based upon the fact that Portland General Electric Company was currently performing construction service in the location that conversion of the street lighting was to take place, coordination with General Telephone of the Northwest had been effected, and the trenching excavation was completed. The DES Transportation Division had budgeted the street lighting and the opportunity was available for an estimated \$20,000 to \$30,000 in cost savings. Action was required by the Transportation Division prior to closing of the trenches.

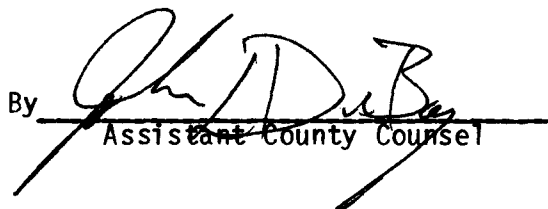
It appearing to the Board that the declaration of emergency is in accord with the requirements of the Multnomah County Public Contract Review Board Administrative Rules AR 10.110, and 30.010; it is, therefore,

**ORDERED** that the conversion of the electrical utilities be exempted from the requirement of public bidding.

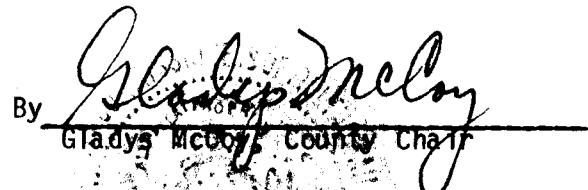
