Reason for Classification Decision:

This new position is funded by a new grant from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. The grant requires a nurse with experience in epidemiology and quantitative analysis to conduct extensive pertussis case investigations and contact follow-up for cases in the Tri-County area. The duties include investigate and control the spread of pertussis and outbreaks by performing a comprehensive health assessment and providing pre or post exposure prophylaxis as appropriate. The position will provide comprehensive community health nursing services directed toward the prevention of pertussis and the promotion of health of the community. These responsibilities are consistent with the Community Health Nurse (6315) classification.
