Ordinance No. 139

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 84, as amended; and revising the fees prescribed by said ordinance.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:


Section 1. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 84, as amended, is amended by adding the following Subsection I.

"Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this section or elsewhere in this ordinance, the license fee for the first license year of any licensee which was in business throughout the entire year preceding its first license year, shall not exceed the greater of (a) \$25.00, or (b) 1.5 percent of its income for the year preceding its first license year less any deduction allowable under subsection C of this section. In the event any such licensee pays a license fee in excess of the amount required under this subsection, then any portion of the licensee's overpayment which has not otherwise been refunded and is not otherwise refundable to the licensee under the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon application by the licensee, be refunded to the licensee without interest; provided, however, no refund shall be allowed under this subsection of all or any part of a minimum fee paid pursuant to Subsection 7.A."

Section 2. The amendment adopted in Section 1 of this ordinance is retroactive and applies to all fees and applications paid or due on or after the effective date of Ordinance No. 84.


