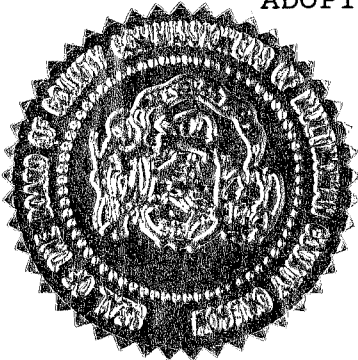
WHEREAS, Multnomah County has an Intergovernmental Agreement with the cities of Portland and Gresham to provide solid waste regulation and waste reduction management to the urban unincorporated areas of Multnomah County; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Service District provides Waste Reduction Challenge Grants to local governments to undertake specific recycling efforts and Multnomah County is eligible for an allocation of \$29,829 of these funds for fiscal year 1991-92; and

WHEREAS, the City of Portland has undertaken the required activities for these funds in the urban unincorporated portion of the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, that Multnomah County authorizes the City of Portland to use Metro's Waste Reduction Challenge Grant for Multnomah County for the year 1991-92, and that Metro be so notified.
