5 An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 937 adding new provisions to Multnomah County
6 Code Chapter 21 relating to workplace hazards to add an exemption from smoke-free workplaces for
7 truck stops in Multnomah County

9 The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- 10 a. Imposition of the County's policy proscribing smoking in the workplace to truck stops
11 may pose an unreasonable hardship on that category of business which integrates a
12 service station with a restaurant.
- 13 b. Only three establishments in Multnomah County meet the definition of a truck stop set
14 out in this Ordinance, and the impact on the countywide smokefree workplace thus is
15 limited.

16 Multnomah County Ordains as follows:

17 **Section 1.** Ordinance No. 937 is amended to add the following definition to MCC
18 §21.501 (insert after line 23 on Page 3 of Ordinance No. 937):

19 **TRUCK STOP.** A facility that provides all of the following: fuel service for vehicles up
20 to ninety feet in length; off-street parking for trucks and trailers; a twenty-four hour restaurant;
21 and driver support services, such as showers, laundry, and truck supplies.

1 **Section 2.** Ordinance No. 937 is amended to add truck stops to MCC §21.503, Places
2 Where Smoking Is Not Regulated, as follows (insert after line 16 on Page 4 of Ordinance No. 937):

3 (G) Truck stops.

4 **Section 3.** This ordinance is effective July 1, 2000.




