

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON
ORDINANCE NO. 266

An ordinance establishing a Multnomah County Emergency Task Force on funding alternatives for neighborhood parks of Multnomah County, and declaring an emergency.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby established a Multnomah County Emergency Task Force to discover alternatives for the funding of neighborhood parks in Multnomah County.

Section 2. The Task Force shall be composed of twelve members appointed by the County Executive and approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

Task Force membership shall be constituted as follows:

- a. A member of the Board of County Commissioners.
- b. Representative from DES.
- c. Four members representing four community planning groups.
- d. Six citizens-at-large.

Section 3. The Task Force shall:

- a. Assess the current state of neighborhood park funding, and evaluate the potential impact of budget changes on neighborhood parks.
- b. Review and evaluate possible funding sources for neighborhood parks, including the possibility of securing funds from the private sector.
- c. Explore the state of current park usage, with estimated projected impact of neighborhood population growth on neighborhood parks.
- d. Make Recommendations on parks funding.

Section 4. The Task Force shall report its findings and recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners on or before March 26, 1981.

Section 5. Emergency. This ordinance being necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the people of Multnomah County, in order to provide input during the budget process, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon the passage by the Board of County Commissioners and authentication by the County Executive.

ADOPTED this 29th day of January, 1981, being the date of its first reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.
