ORDINANCE NO. 146

An Ordinance relating to minimum pensions for certain retired employees; amending Section 3 of Ordinance No. 142; and declaring an emergency.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 142 is amended to read:

"Section 3.

(a) Benefits payable under a joint annuity option under Section 9.G. of Ordinance No. 78 shall be appropriately adjusted to conform to the minimum benefits payable by reason of this Ordinance.

(b) Benefits payable to employees who have elected voluntary early retirement under Sections 4.C. and 9.F. of Ordinance No. 78 shall be proportionately adjusted to conform to minimum benefits payable by reason of this Ordinance."


Section 2. The provisions of this amending Ordinance shall apply retroactively to March 1, 1977.

Section 3. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety by providing increased benefits for certain retired employees, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
