Membership includes a pool of appointees from the County's governing body or non-office holding County residents to serve in their place; non-office holding residents of the County who are not employees of the County or of any taxing district within the County or a member of the governing body of a school district within the County. Debi Huff is the BoPTA Clerk. The program offer is 72025A-16 included in the Adopted FY17 Budget.
