**PROCLAMATION NO. 2014-076**

Proclaiming June 2014 as PRIDE Month for the LGBTQ Community in Multnomah County, Oregon.

**The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:**


- a. June marks the 44<sup>th</sup> annual recognition of Gay Pride Month, now recognized as Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer (LGBTQ) PRIDE Month throughout the United States;
- b. This month was chosen to commemorate the dedication, bravery, and sacrifice of those who led the 1969 uprising at the Stonewall Tavern in Greenwich Village, which sparked the modern LGTBQ consciousness movement in the United States;
- c. LGBTQ citizens of Multnomah County are actively engaged in every neighborhood, school, business, and election, yet continue to confront discrimination, bullying stereotyping, harassment, and violence;
- d. Multnomah County has been the site of Pride celebrations each third weekend in June, with Multnomah County government supporting Pride Month celebrations since 1992;
- e. Multnomah County's Office of Diversity and Equity sponsor's Prism, a "full-spectrum" Employee Resource Group comprised of over 80 LGBTQ and ally members who contribute to the ongoing mission of inclusion and equity in Multnomah County.

June 2014 as PRIDE Month for the LGBTQ Community in Multnomah County, Oregon and with this proclamation affirms commitment to supporting LGBTQ issues.


