Reason for Classification Decision:

This position is responsible for procuring and providing results of laboratory tests on various patient specimens to aid in the diagnosis and treatment of medical clients. The incumbent performs phlebotomy procedures and testing in the areas of hematology, bacteriology, clinical chemistry, parasitology, urinalysis, coagulation, and microscopic examination. The position researches and evaluates new technology and equipment to make recommendations regarding usefulness and effectiveness within the clinic; develops, maintains and revises operating procedures for laboratory testing; manages quality assurance; and coordinates and directs the activities of the laboratory within the clinic. Qualifications are an Associates degree in Medical Laboratory Technology, certification as a Medical Laboratory Technician (MLT) through ASCO, with one year of laboratory experience desired. Based on these duties, responsibilities and qualifications the appropriate classification is Medical Laboratory Technician (6333).
