**WHEREAS**, The 1991-1992 Oregon State Legislature enacted statute permitting counties to assume administrative responsibility for Juvenile Parole within their respective jurisdictions; and

**WHEREAS**, Multnomah County has previously assumed local responsibility for downsizing of the State Training Schools; and

**WHEREAS**, Multnomah County is responsible for managing its local cap at the State Training Schools; and

**WHEREAS**, The Children's Services Division of the State of Oregon has requested Multnomah County to submit an application to become a Pilot County under the terms of House Bill 3438; and


**WHEREAS**, The Juvenile Justice Division, with the assistance of local service providers, Juvenile Parole and community organizations, has developed a comprehensive plan allowing Multnomah County to participate in the implementation of House Bill 3438.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED**, that Multnomah County will become a Pilot County with the State of Oregon in the implementation of House Bill 3438, upon execution of an inter-governmental agreement approved by the Board of County Commissioners.


