WHEREAS, requests for certain tax-foreclosed properties were received pursuant to procedures set forth in Multnomah County Ordinance No. 672 and the Multnomah County Housing Affordability Demonstration Program; and

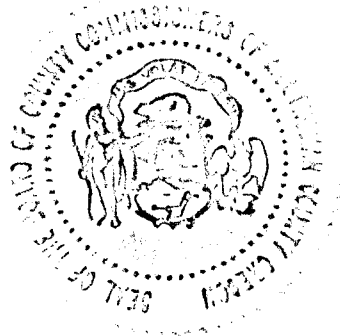
WHEREAS, staff reported said requests to the Board of Commissioners in a public meeting on December 19, 1991 and the Board set a date for public hearing in the matter; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Board of Commissioners on January 9, 1992 to determine whether the transfer request would serve the public purpose of providing decent, safe and sanitary low-income housing, and the Board being fully informed in the matter; now therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the transfer of tax-foreclosed property described as BARTONS ADDITION, LOT 4, BLOCK 3, formerly known as 10036 North Oswego Avenue, to the non-profit AFFORDABLE HOUSING CORPORATION, for public purposes under the County Housing Affordability Demonstration Program, be and hereby is approved; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Chair be and hereby is authorized to execute all documentation required to complete said transfer.
