WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes the need for developing separate intergovernmental agreements (IGA) between the County and the Cities of Fairview, Gresham, Troutdale and Wood Village; and

WHEREAS, the goal of the Memorandum of Understanding is to provide the basis for sharing responsibilities for road capital and maintenance services, functions and resources between Multnomah County; the Cities of Fairview, Gresham, Troutdale and Wood Village; and

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Understanding evolved from an open process between the County and the Cities intending to reduce actual and potential conflicts between jurisdictions for road construction and maintenance responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, four clear objectives have emerged from this process with respect to improving coordination and clarifying relationships with respect to capital improvements; and

WHEREAS, these objectives are: (1) to physically define the roads within the sub-regional network, (2) to involve the Cities in the development of the County's Capital Improvement Plan, (3) to fully coordinate schedules of road construction, reconstruction, or major maintenance activities between jurisdictions, and (4) to permit the Cities to assume responsibilities for development review on all County roads within their boundaries; and

WHEREAS, three recommendations have emerged from this process with respect to ongoing maintenance of roads which are not part of the sub-regional network; and

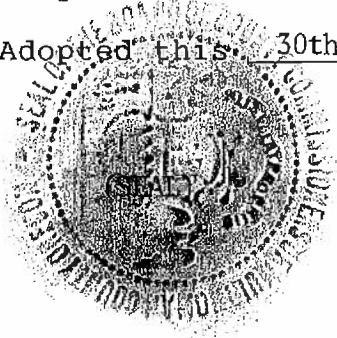
WHEREAS, these recommendations are: (1) to transfer maintenance responsibilities for all roads which are not part of the sub-regional network from the County to the Cities, (2) to transfer funds, equipment or personnel necessary to insure that the Cities have sufficient adequate resources to provide a continuing level of maintenance, and (3) to provide the Cities with the option in the IGA's, to enter into a purchase of service or sharing agreements with the County; and



NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County accept the Memorandum of Understanding between Multnomah County and the Cities of Fairview, Gresham, Troutdale and Wood Village for the purposes of sharing road capital and maintenance functions and responsibilities within Multnomah County.
