Declaring the Week of May 19 through May 25, 2002 as National Public Works Week and Recognizing the Contributions of All Multnomah County Public Works Employees

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:


- a. The public works services provided in Multnomah County are an integral part of the everyday lives of its citizens; and
- b. The support of an understanding and informed citizenry is vital to the efficient operation of public works systems, programs, and facilities, such as streets, highways, bridges, emergency management, animal control, and public buildings; and
- c. It is vital that the citizens of Multnomah County recognize and appreciate the importance of the public works infrastructure and the value of public works built and maintained in Multnomah County; and
- d. The health, safety, comfort, and economy of Multnomah County citizens greatly depend on these facilities and services; and
- e. The quality and effectiveness of public works projects and services enjoyed by citizens of Multnomah County are dependent upon the efforts and skills of the public works employees; and
- f. The efficiency of the qualified and dedicated personnel who staff public works departments is materially influenced by the citizens of Multnomah County and their understanding of the importance of the work they perform.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Proclaims:

The week of May 19 through 25, 2002 as "NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK," and calls upon the citizens of this community to recognize the contributions that all public works employees make every day to our health, safety, comfort, and economic prosperity.
