Waiving Mobile Unit Class 1 (food cart) license fees for up to 12 nontraditional food service operators.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. The Health Department has developed a pilot project to determine if a model that includes culturally competent training on food safety and business practices coupled with a new model of mobile unit will support nontraditional food service operators to seek licensure and inspections that help ensure sales of safe food. The pilot project will include 10-12 nontraditional food service operators.
- b. The Health Department will perform all relevant classifications and inspections according to law; however, the Health Department seeks permission to waive the related fees.
- c. Waiving Mobile Unit Class 1 (food cart) license fees for 10-12 nontraditional food service operators will help the Health Department determine the pilot project's viability. Mobile Unit Class 1 fees include the following:
 - a. Mobile Unit Class 1 \$370.00
 - b. Commissary Fee \$340.00
 - c. Plan Review \$405.00
- d. The pilot project is funded by a U.S. Food and Drug Administration grant, and there will be no loss of fee revenue for the County.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

1. To waive Mobile Unit Class 1 fees for the pilot project.


