RESOLUTION NO. 2011-116

Ratifying the Appointment to Oregon State Representative, District 46

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. Effective at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, September 1, 2011, there is a vacancy in Oregon State Representative, District 46, due to the resignation of Representative Ben Cannon.
- b. Pursuant to state law, the Democratic Party Precinct Committeepersons of Representative District 46 met to choose nominees to fill the vacancy.
- c. The nominees chosen were: Alissa Keny-Guyer, Rob Milesnick, and Trisha Parks.
- d. In accordance with procedures established by the Secretary of State, the Multnomah County Board of Commissioners considered the nominations at a special meeting at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, September 27, 2011.
- e. At the conclusion of the special meeting, the Commissioners voted to appoint Alissa Keny-Guyer to fill the vacancy.
- f. Under Board meeting rules adopted by Resolution 07-014, Board action at a special meeting does not take effect unless ratified at the next regular meeting.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

1. The Board approves and ratifies the appointment of Alissa Keny-Guyer to fill the vacancy in the Legislative Assembly, Oregon State Representative District 46 on September 27, 2011, by Resolution No. 2011-114.


