1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

Approval of Amendment No. 1 to the County-City Streetcar IGA.

The County-City Streetcar IGA authorized the County to charge up to \$600,000 to the City's Eastside Streetcar Loop project for inspection services on the County-owned/maintained bridges. This IGA increases the amount that the County can charge to \$775,000.

The Amendment will result in an additional \$175,000 of income to the Bridge Division between January and December 2011.
