**ORDINANCE NO. 945**

Amending Ordinance No. 944 Establishing Land Use Fees by Resolution to Add June 1, 2000 Effective Date, and Declaring an Emergency.

**The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:**

- a. On April 13, 2000, the Board adopted Ordinance No. 944 changing the method of collecting land use fees from a deposit system to a flat fee schedule to improve customer service.
- b. On April 13, 2000, the Board adopted Resolution Nos. 00-044 and 00-045 establishing fee schedules for all land use actions to be effective June 1, 2000.
- c. Since no effective date is specified in Ordinance No. 944, it is effective 30 days after adoption.
- d. It is necessary to amend Ordinance No. 944 to add an effective date of June 1, 2000, as provided in the resolutions.

**Multnomah County Ordains as follows:**

**Section 1.** Ordinance No. 944 is amended to add an effective date. as follows:


Section 24. This ordinance takes effect on June 1, 2000.

**Section 2.** This ordinance, being necessary for the health, safety, and general welfare of the people of Multnomah County, an emergency is declared and the ordinance shall take effect upon its execution by the County Chair, pursuant to section 5.50 of the Charter of Multnomah County.


