RESOLUTION NO. 2018-102

Approving a Contract-Specific Special Procurement for Lab Testing through Quest Diagnostics

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. The Board, acting as the Multnomah County Public Contract Review Board (PCRB) and pursuant to PCRB Rule 47-0285, must approve special procurements for service contracts of \$150,000 or more.
- b. The Health Department currently contracts with Quest Diagnostics, Inc. to perform lab testing for all of its clinics as well as for the provision of a Lab Medical Director. After procurement planning was initiated, the Department determined that development of the solicitation document required additional stakeholders, adding complexity and time to the drafting process, and that at least two years of transition time was required for purposes of system recoding and testing if a contract was awarded to a new supplier.
- c. This contract-specific special procurement with Quest Diagnostics, Inc. extends the current contract for four years to provide continued lab diagnostic services using previously established protocols and software systems while the Program conducts a formal solicitation process and builds in transition timelines to the existing contract.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

To approve a contract-specific special procurement authorizing the County to contract with Quest Diagnostics from December 25, 2018 to December 24, 2022 for an estimated \$2,000,000.
