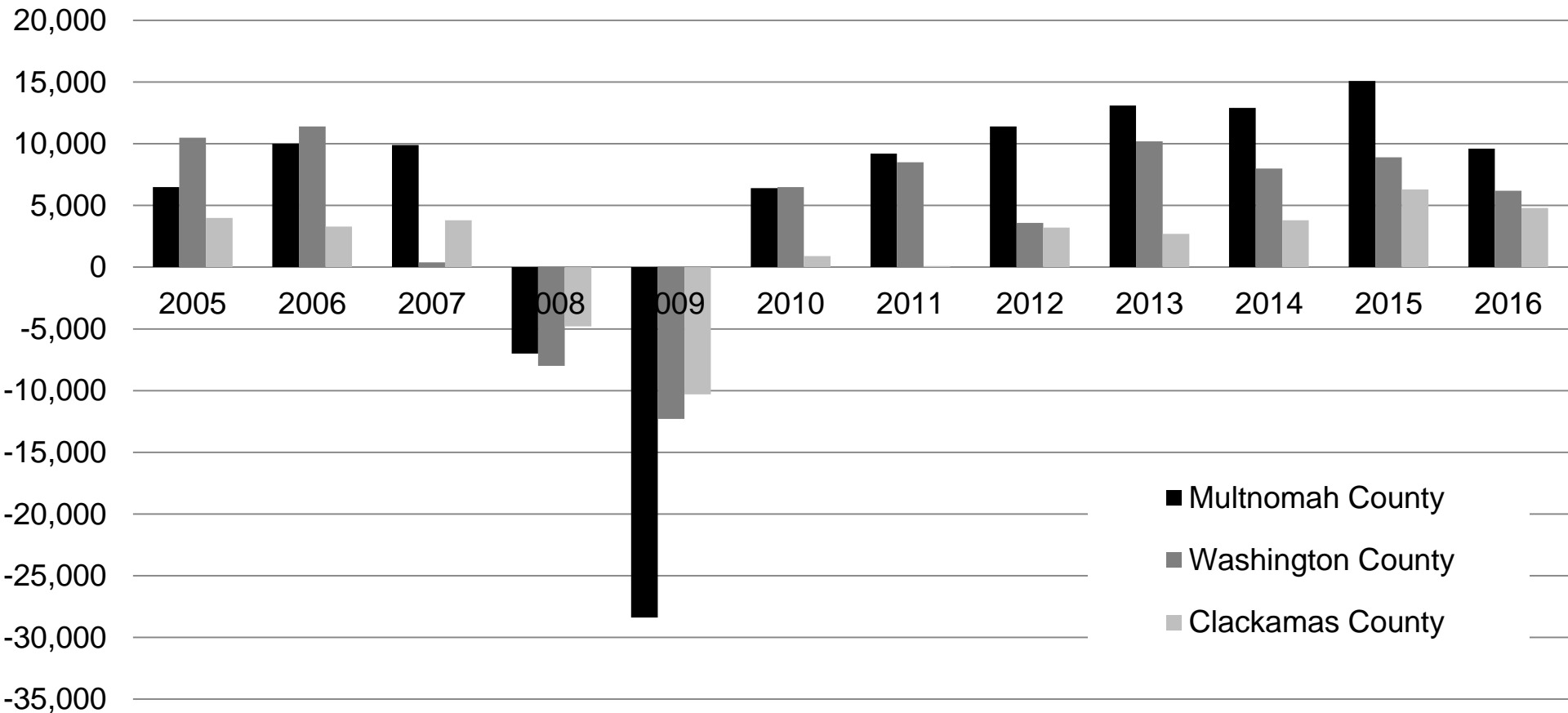

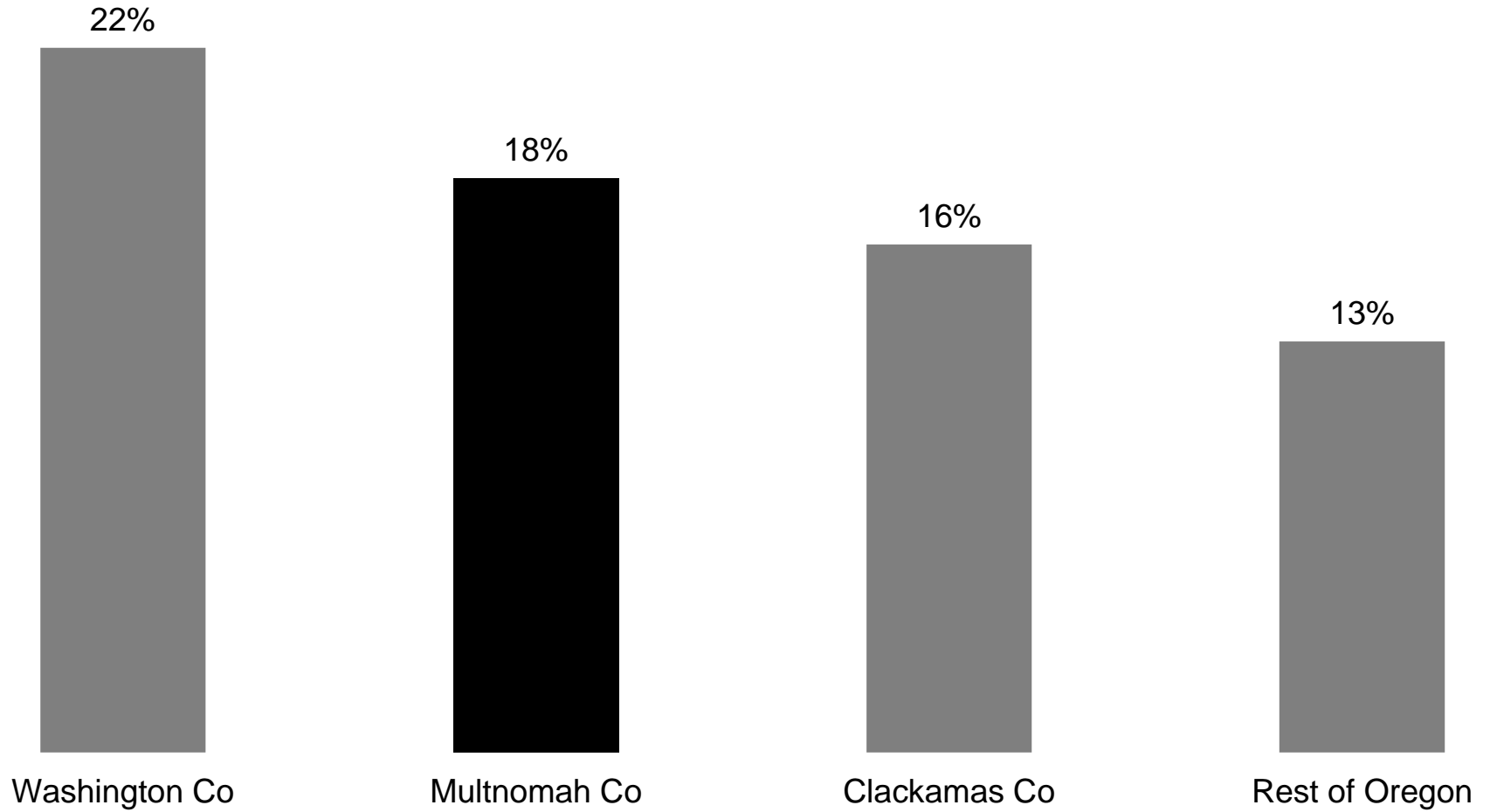
Employment Growth by County

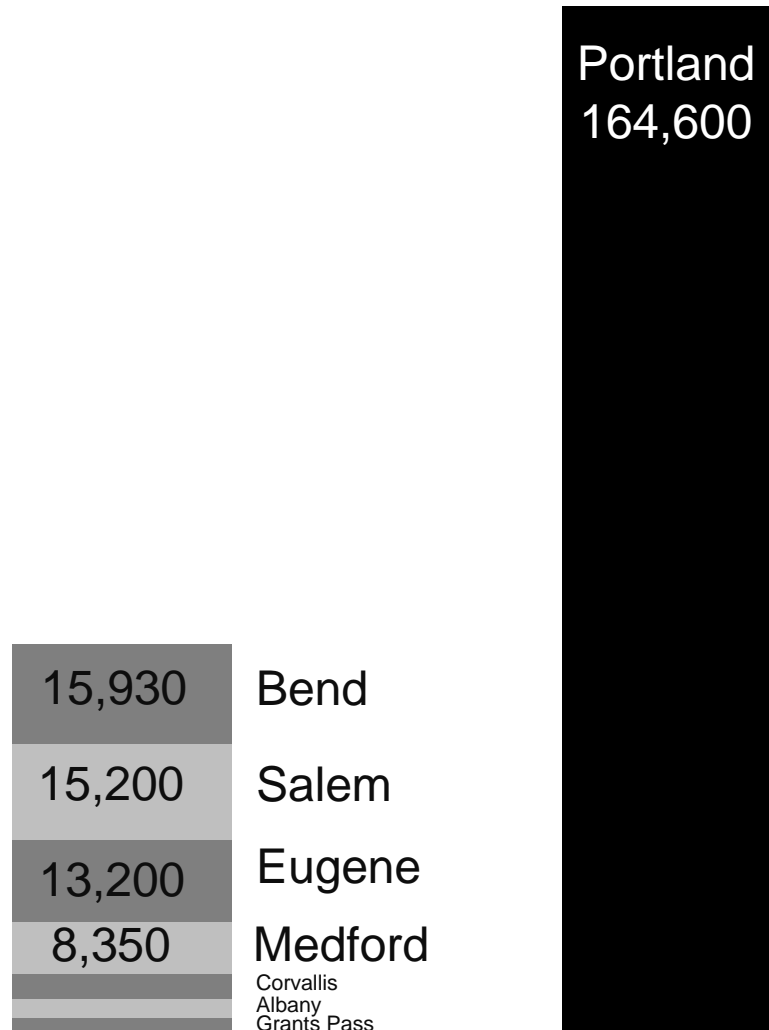
Employment Growth by US State

Nov 2015 to Nov 2016



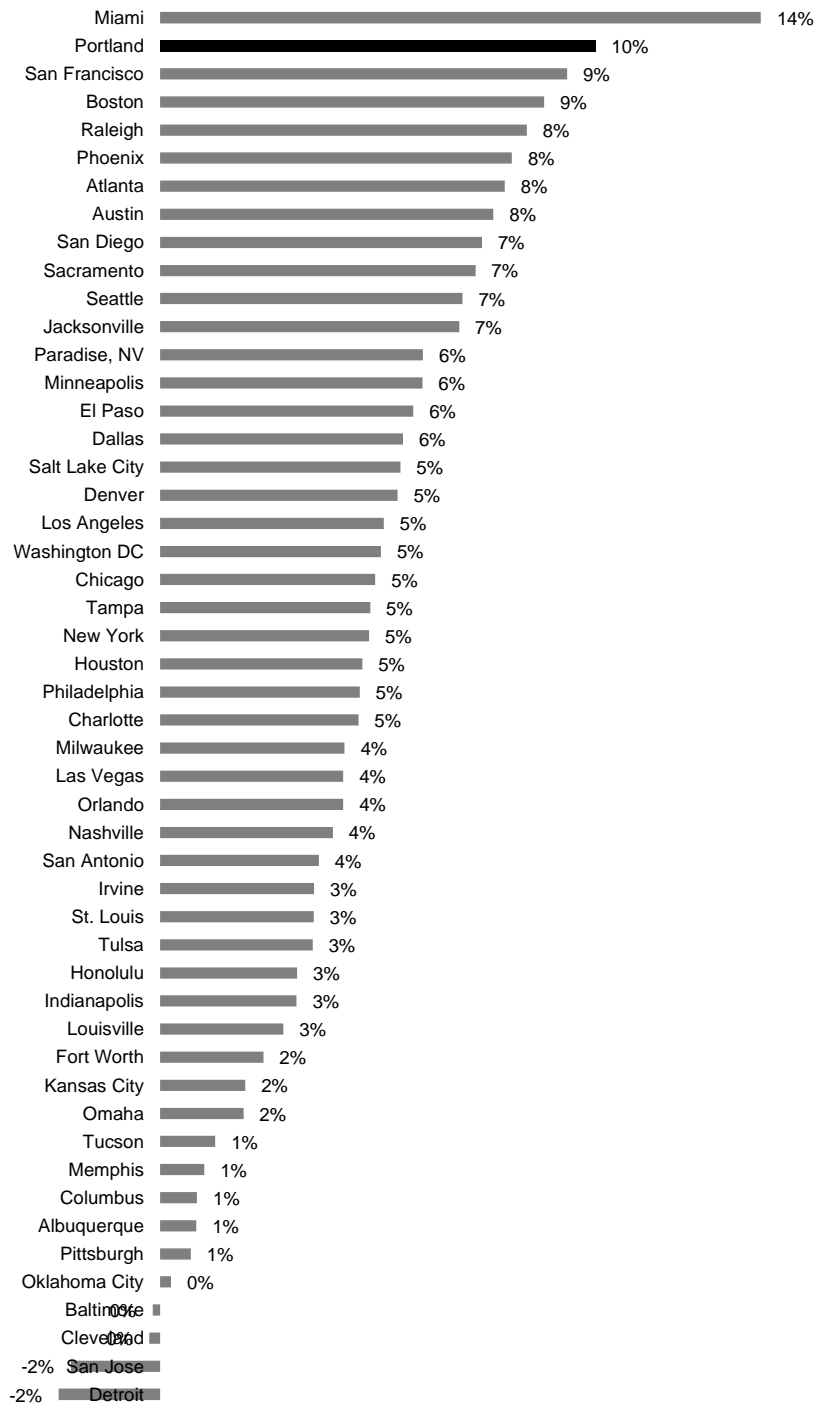
Job Growth by Metro

That's 2.5 times more jobs than the other six Oregon Metros combined.



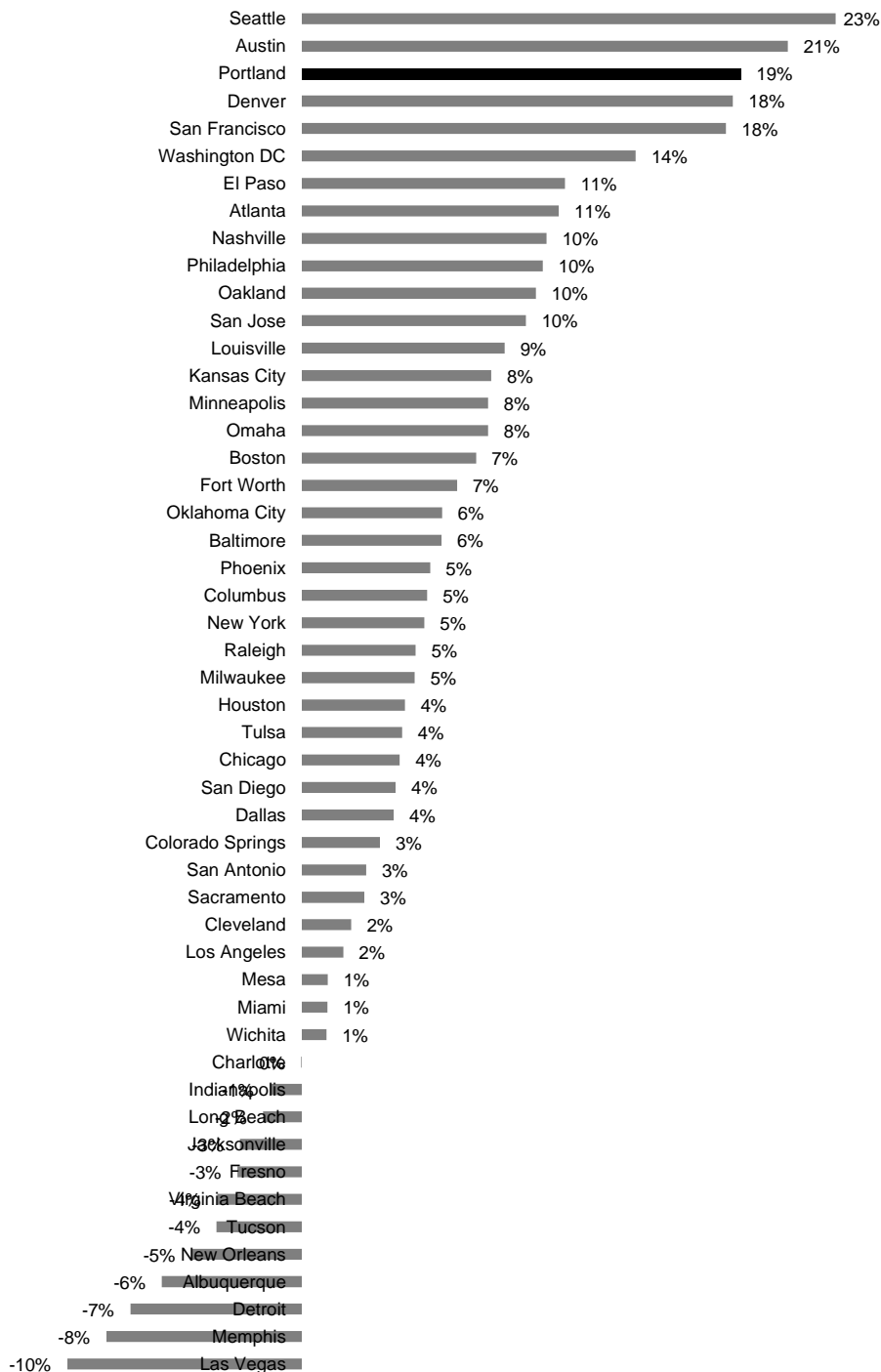
Employment Growth by US City

2013 to 2015

Portland enjoyed the second fastest job growth rate among the 50 largest US cities. That's more than twice the growth rate of the United States.

The city of Portland added 42,062 jobs within the city limits from 2013 to 2015. That's more than Salt Lake City, Las Vegas and Milwaukee combined.

Median Household Income Growth by US City 2010 to 2015

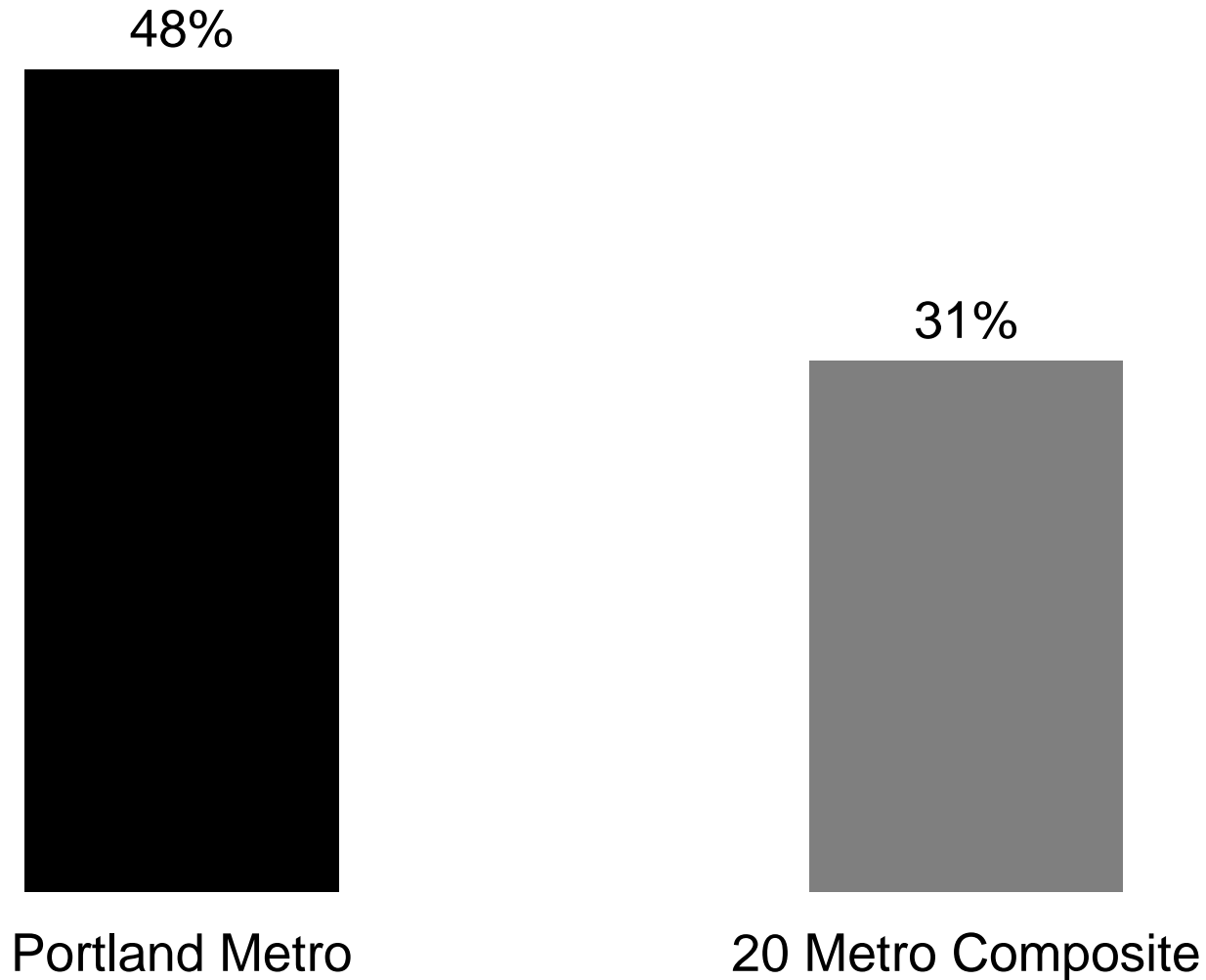


Portland enjoyed the third largest increase in household income among the 50 largest US cities. That's more than seven times the growth rate of the United States at 2.5%. (Inflation adjusted.)

That increase of \$9,604 from 2010 to 2015 brought Portland from being the 17th wealthiest city to the 8th among the 50 largest US cities.

Housing Price Index S&P CoreLogic Case-Shiller

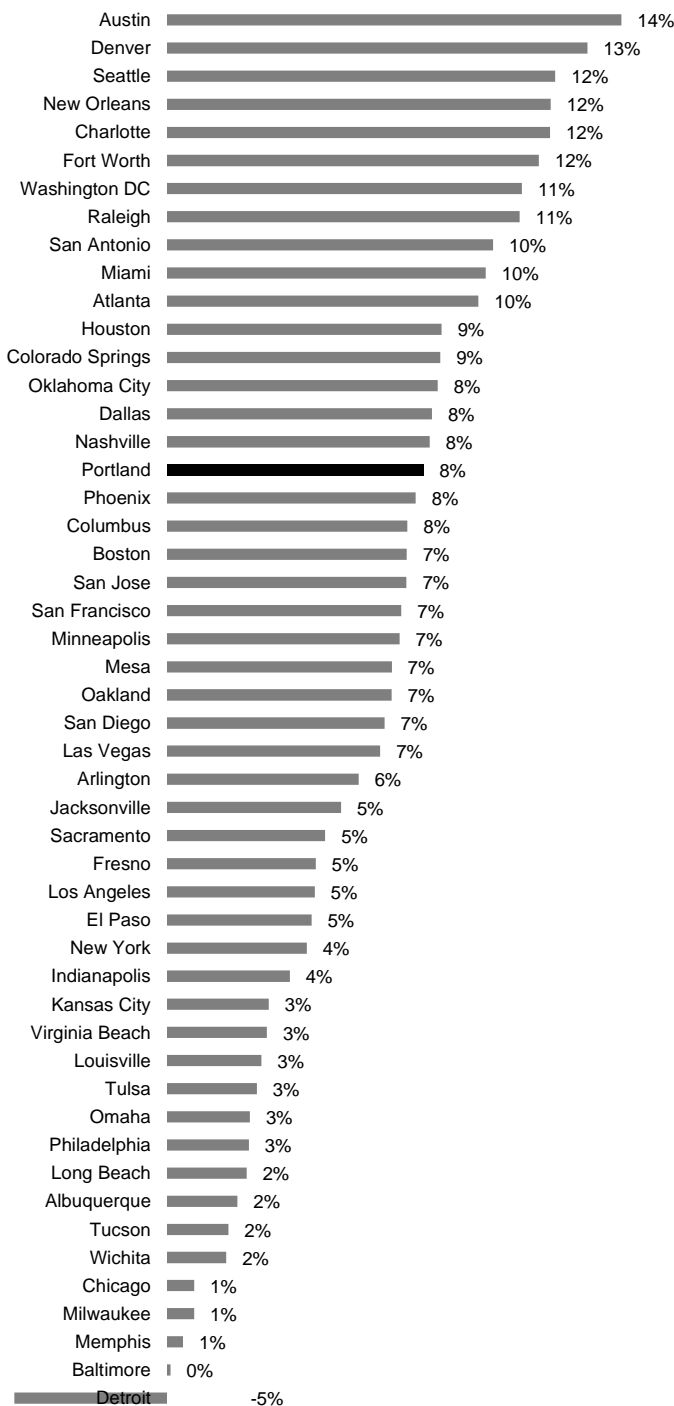

The population of the city of Portland grew by 8% from 2010 to 2015, slightly faster than the 6.7% average growth rate among the 50 largest US cities.



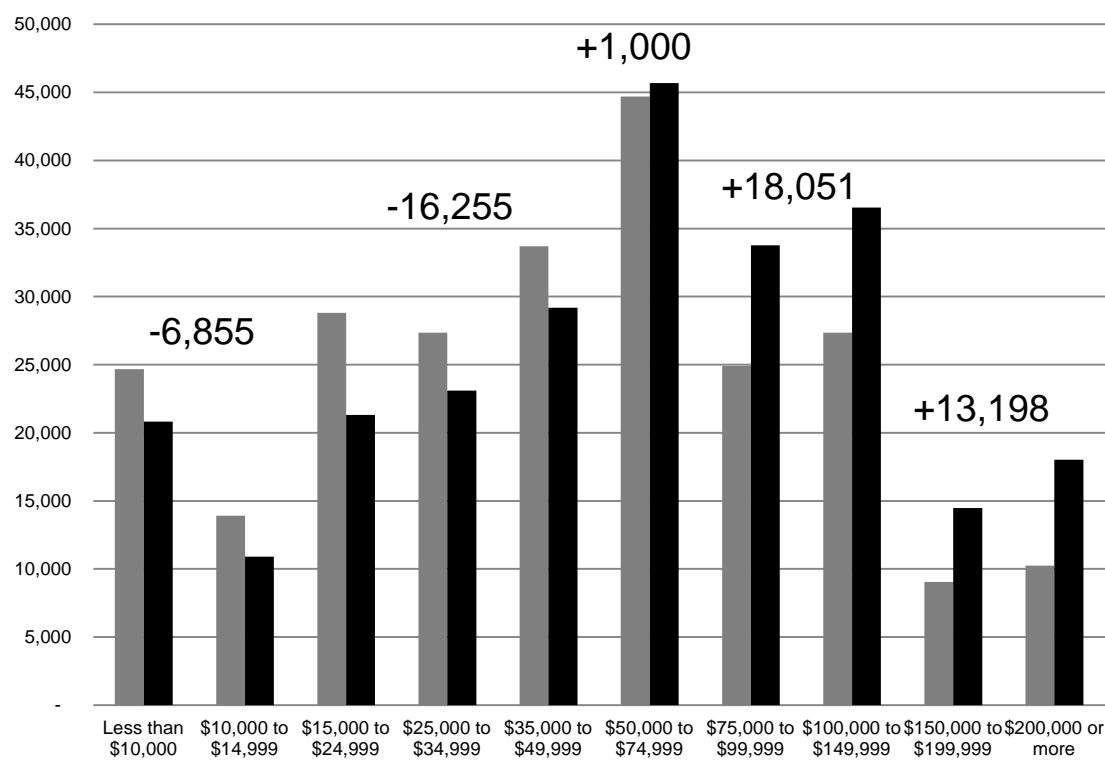

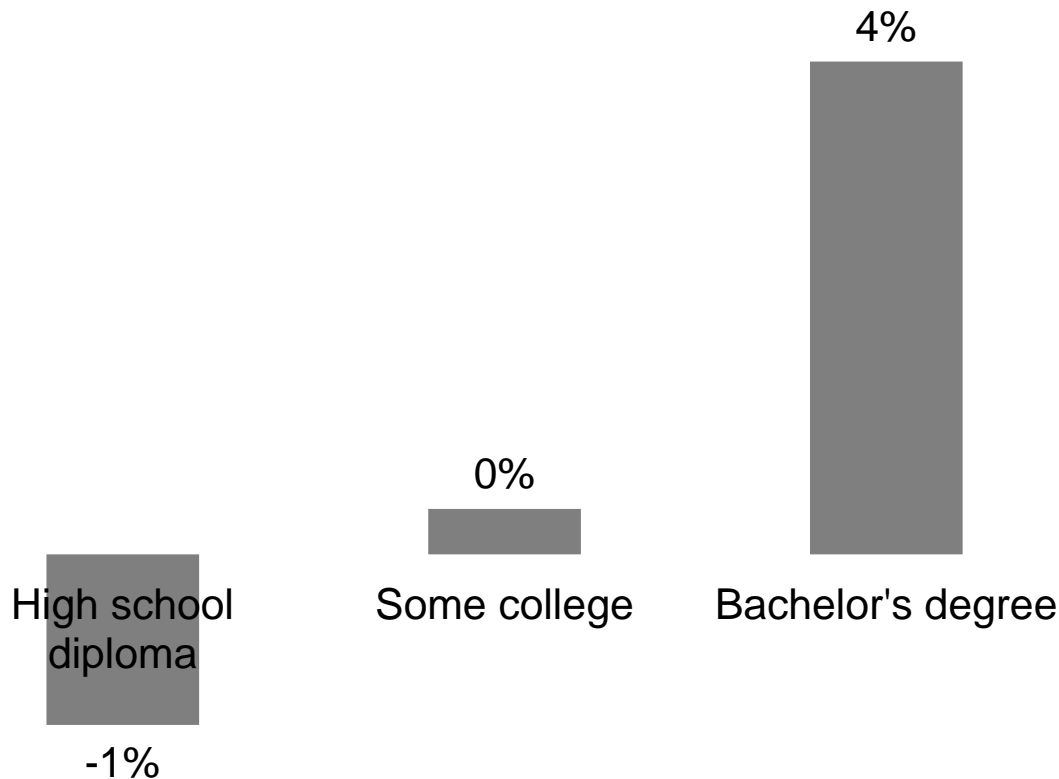
Households with incomes of more than \$100,000 grew by 50%.

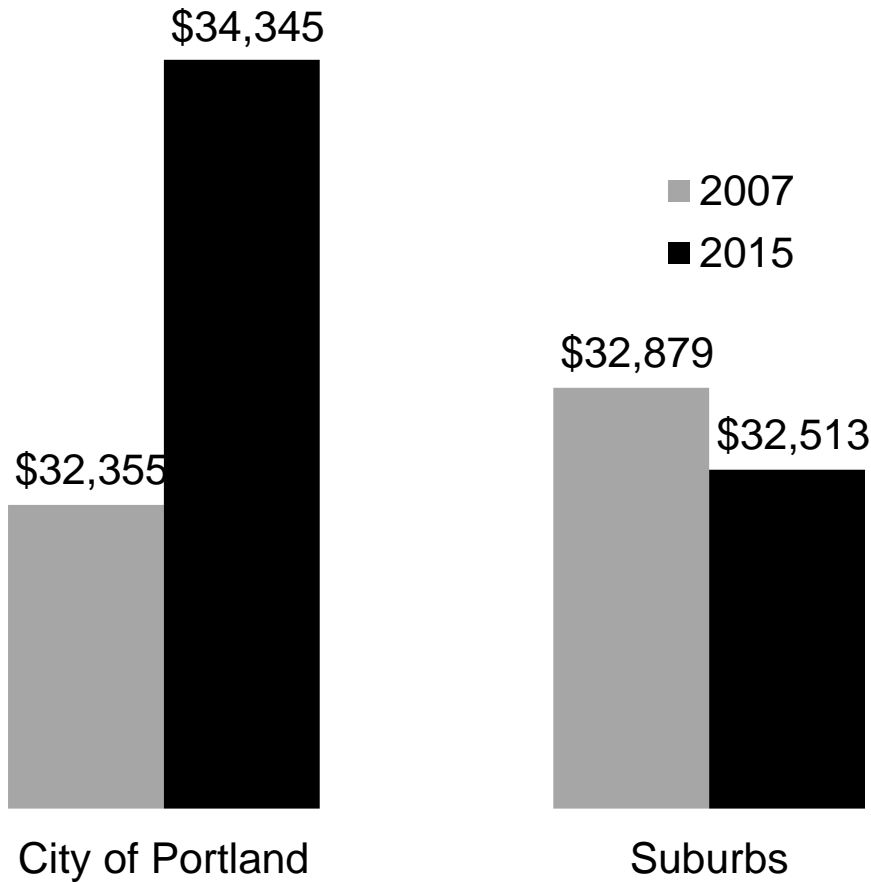

For High School graduates, the median income is \$29,814, down slightly from 2009.

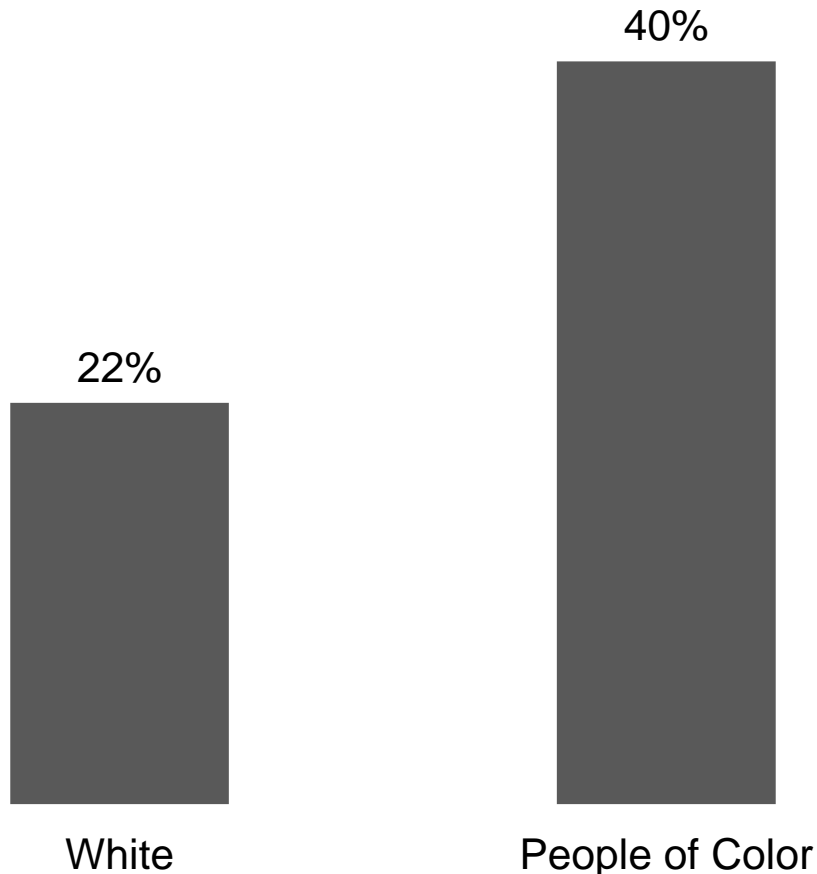
Per Capita Income by Residence



Per Capita Income for residents of Portland is up 6 percent from before the recession in 2007.

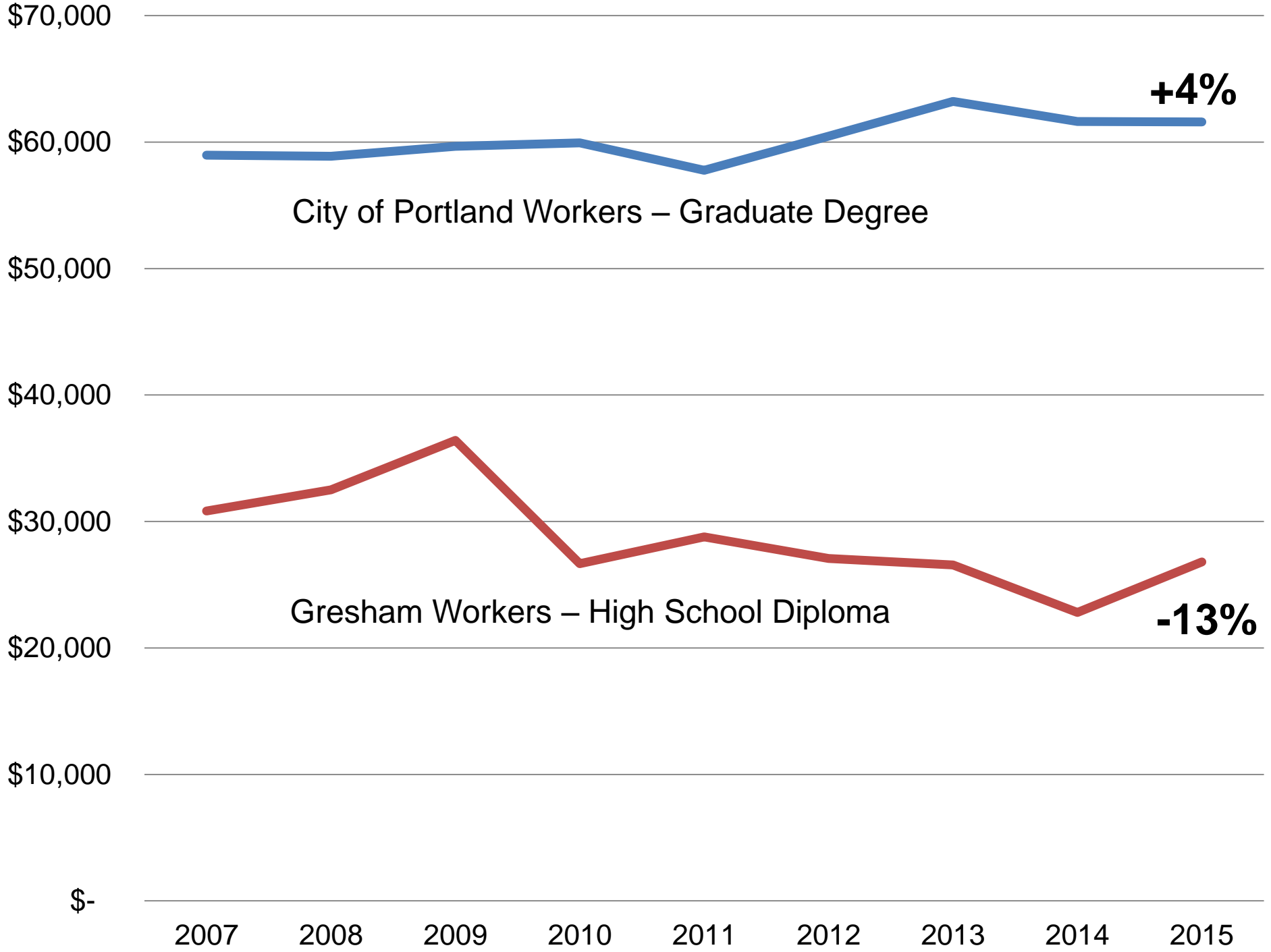
For regional residents outside of the city, the median income is down slightly from 2007.

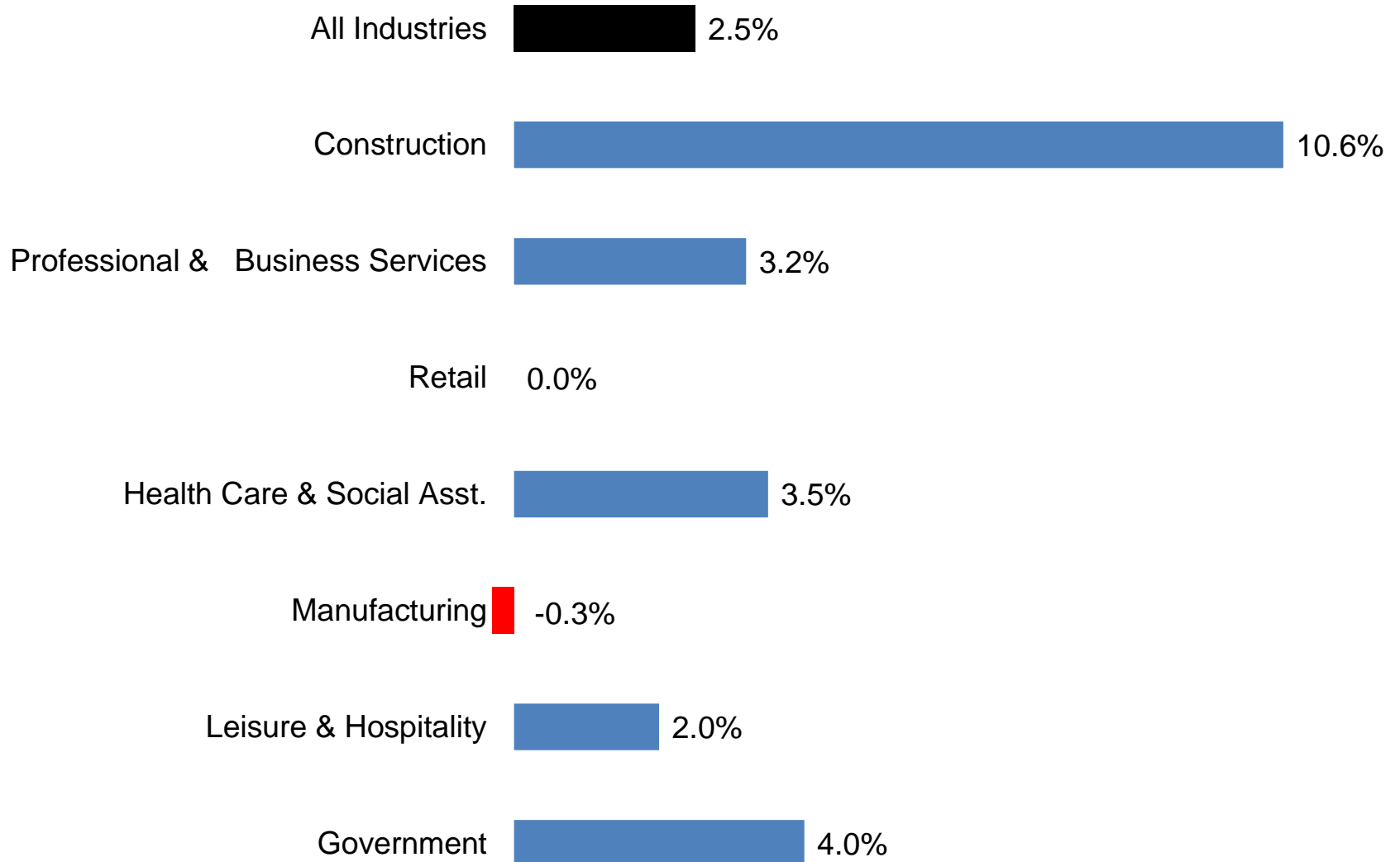

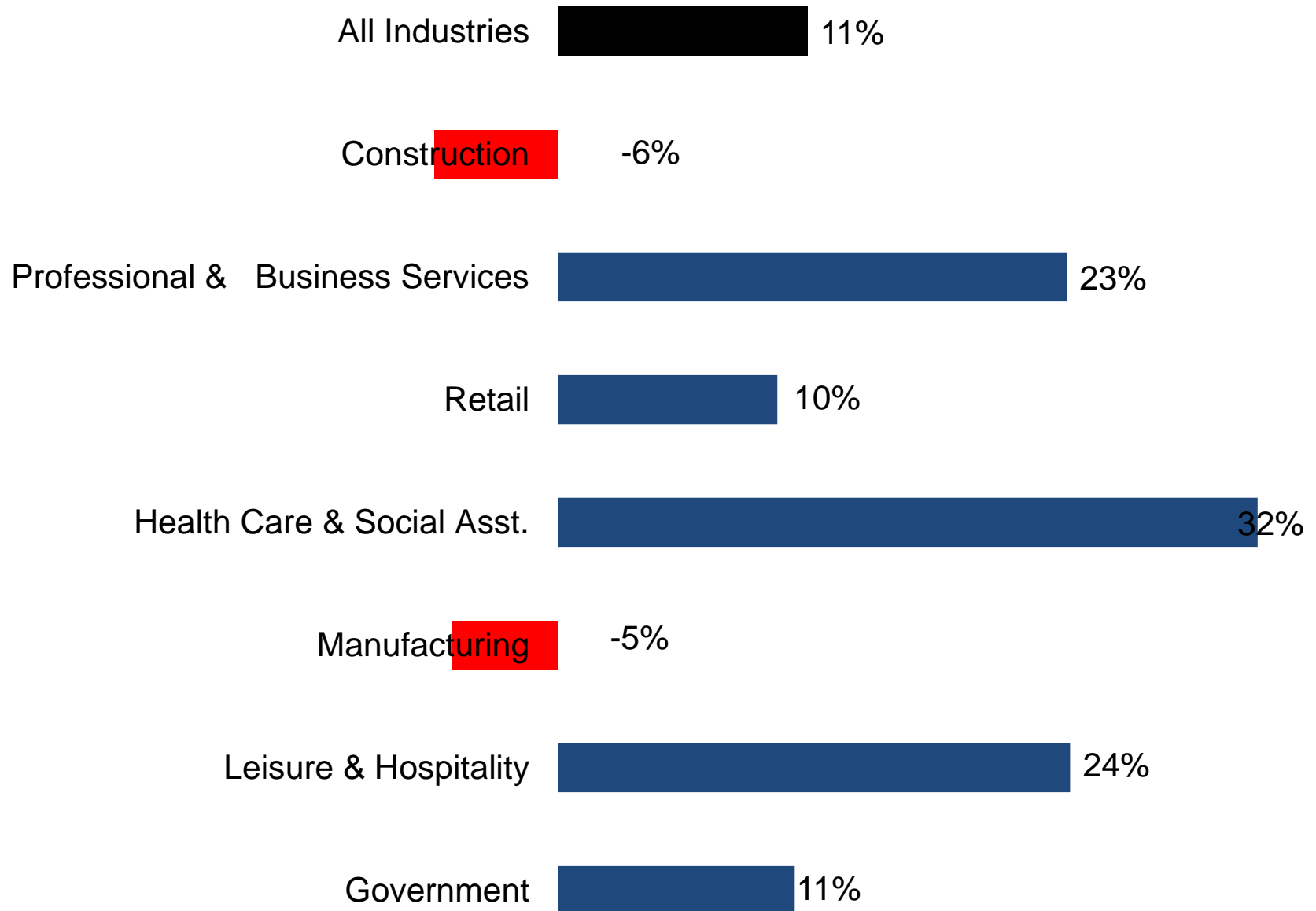
Portland Metro Industry Growth

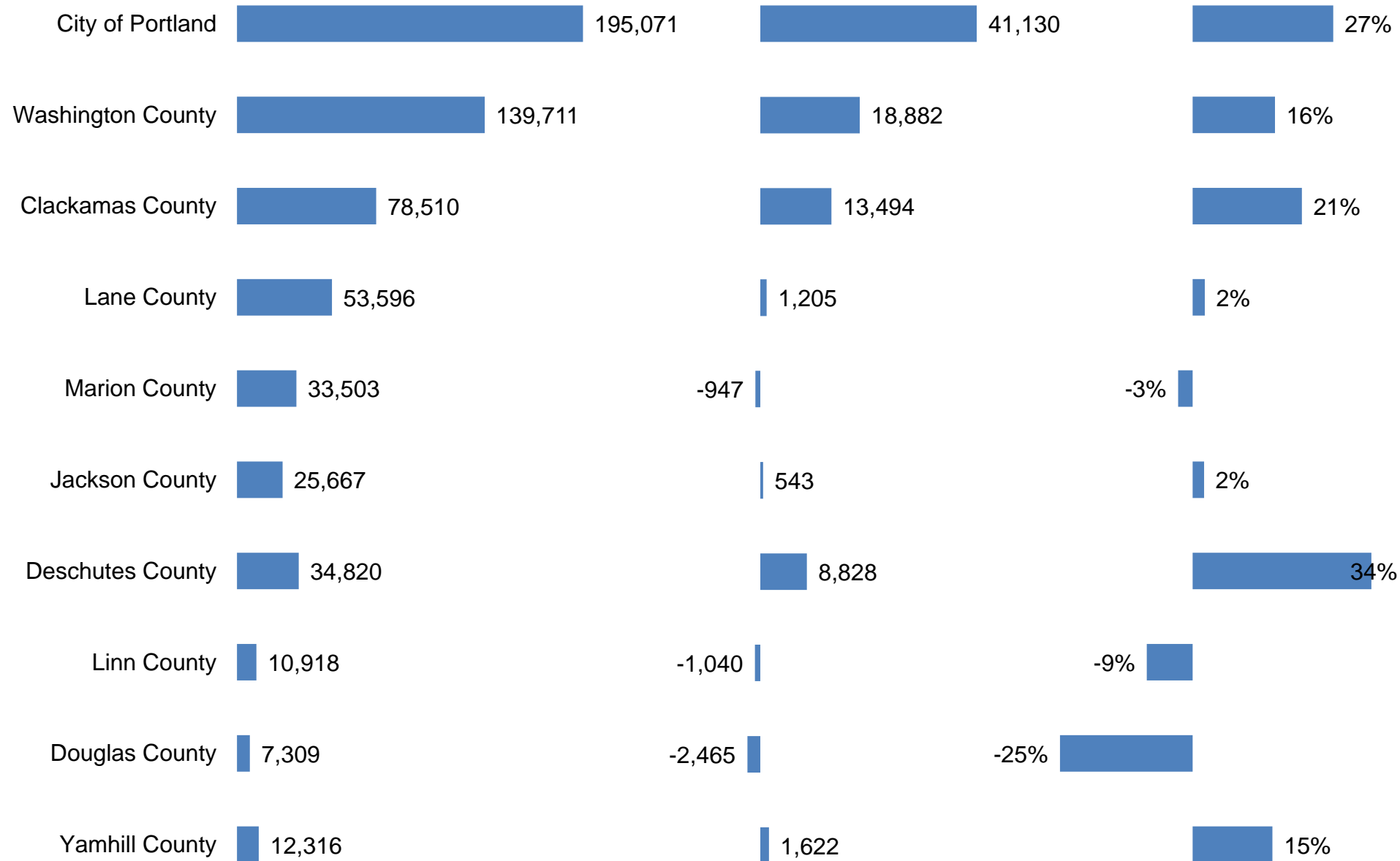

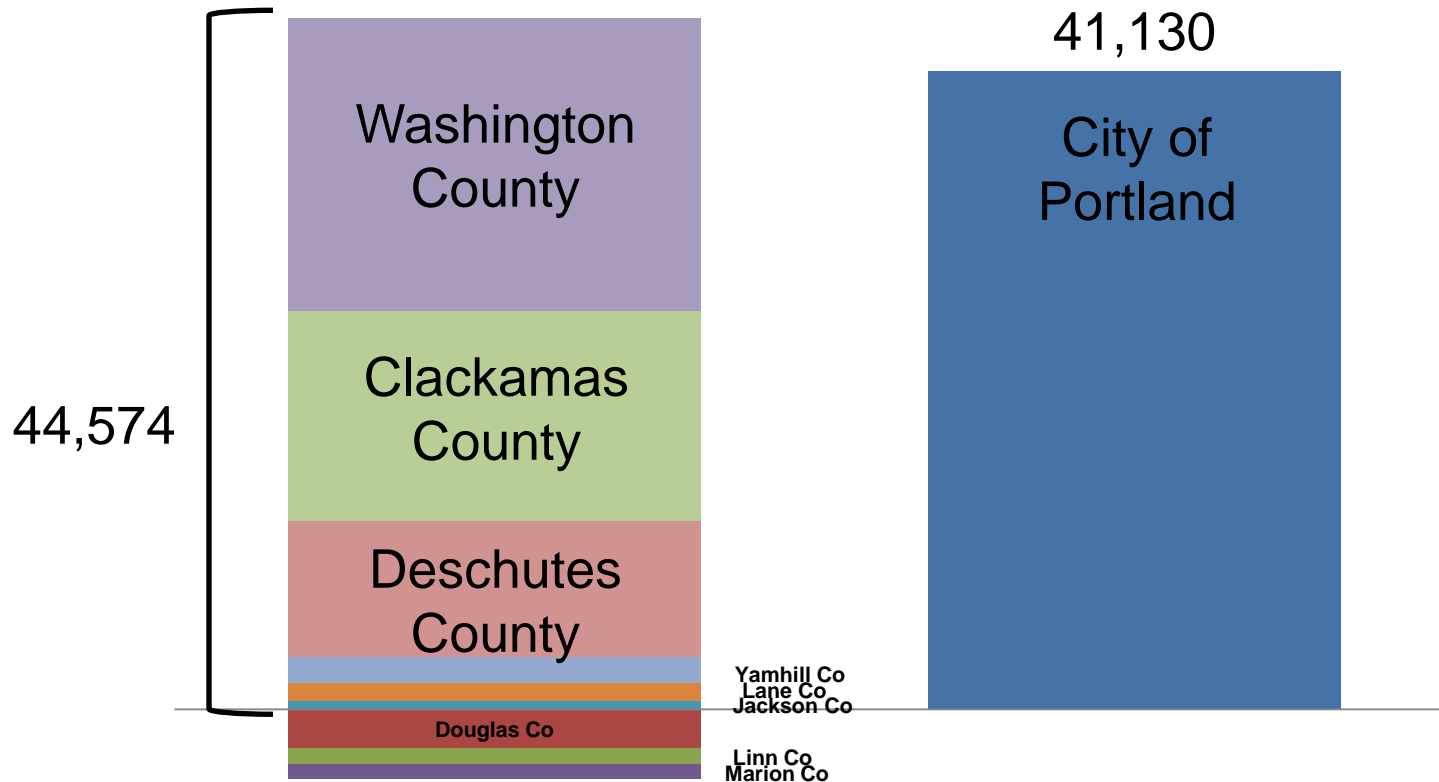

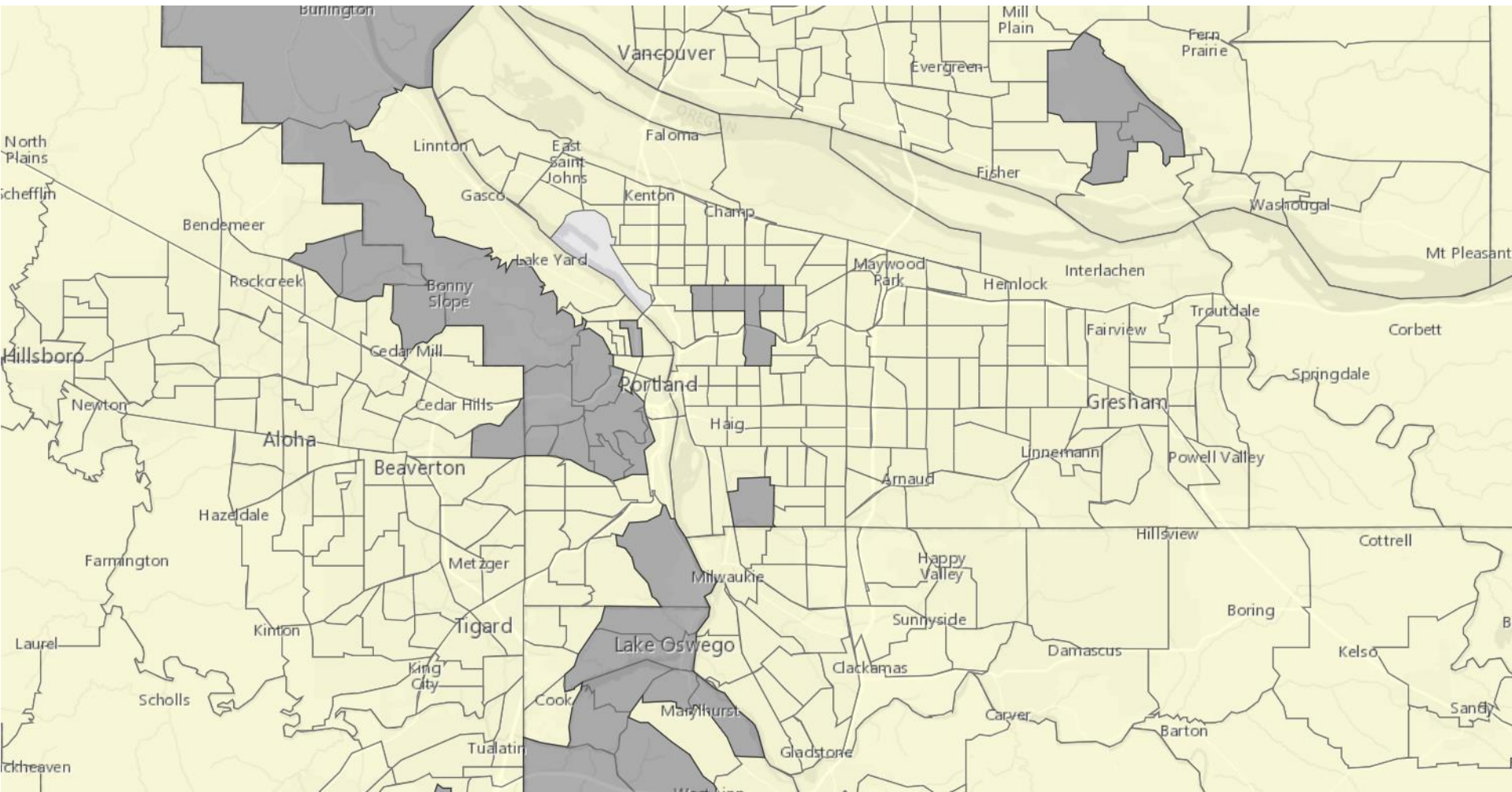

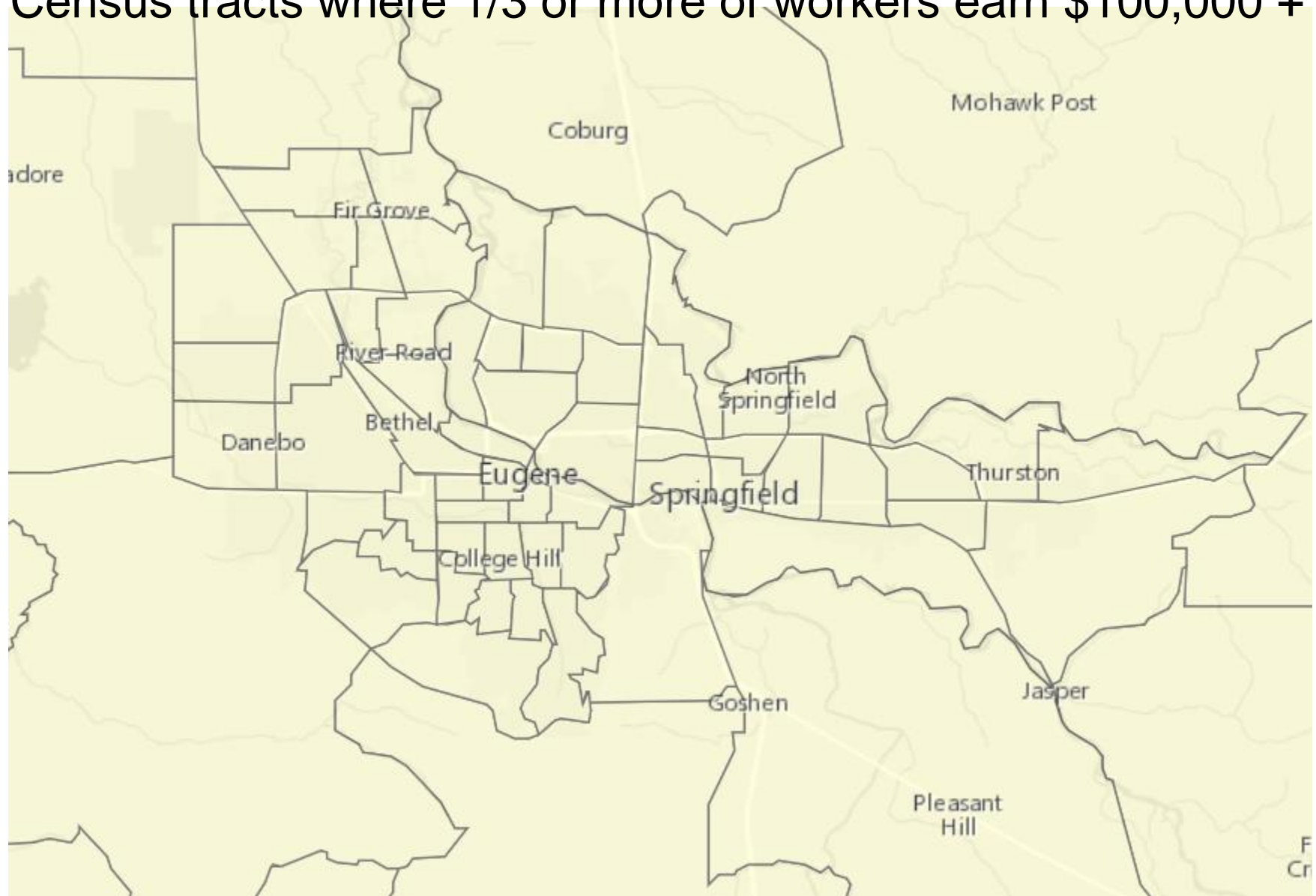

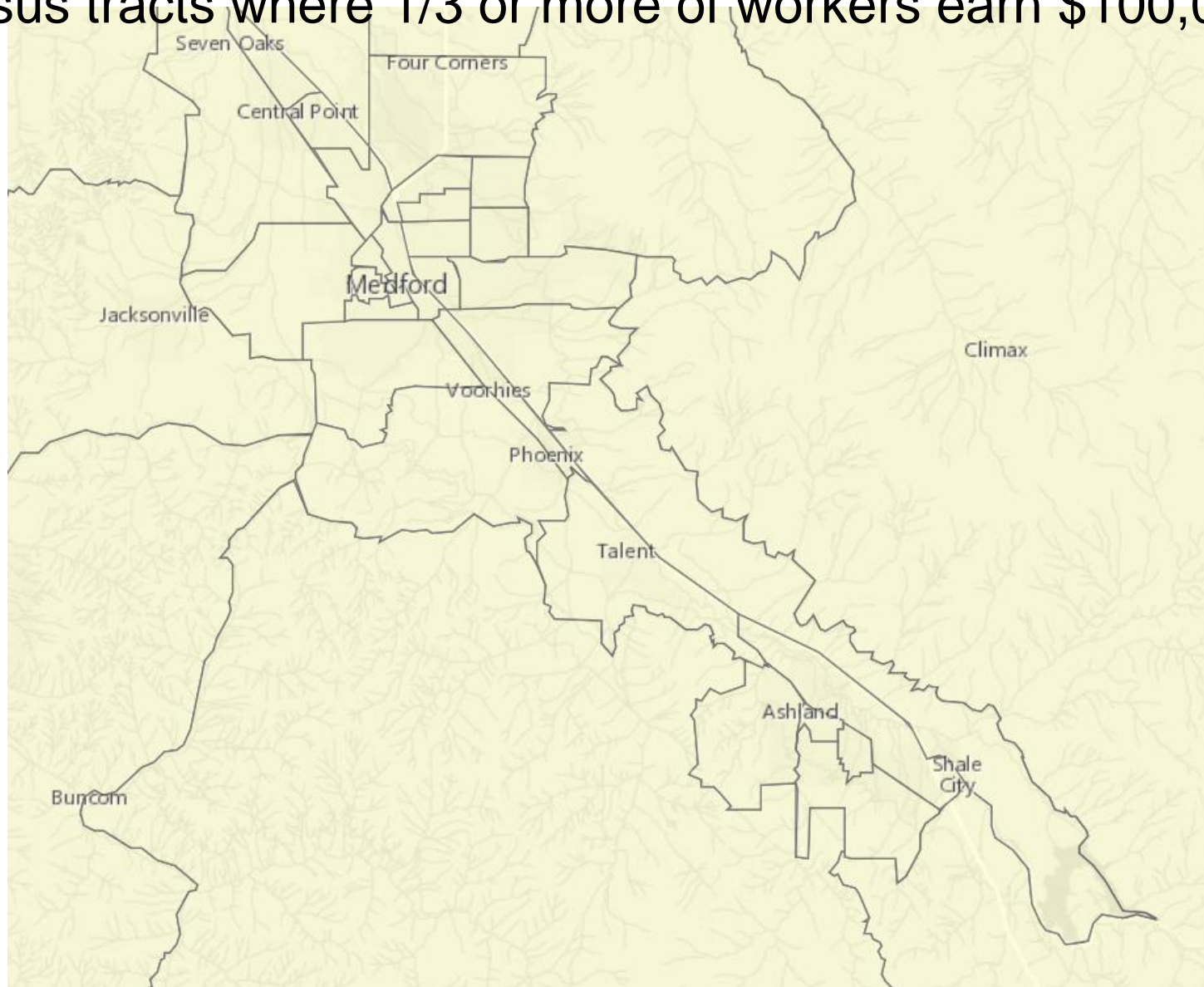

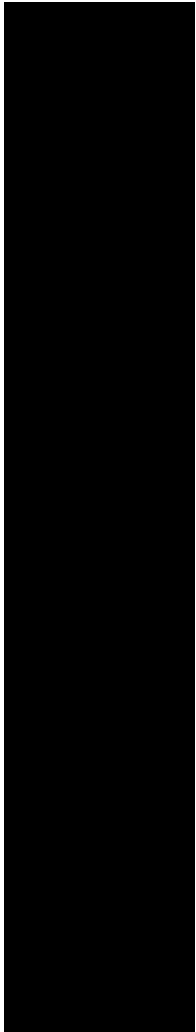

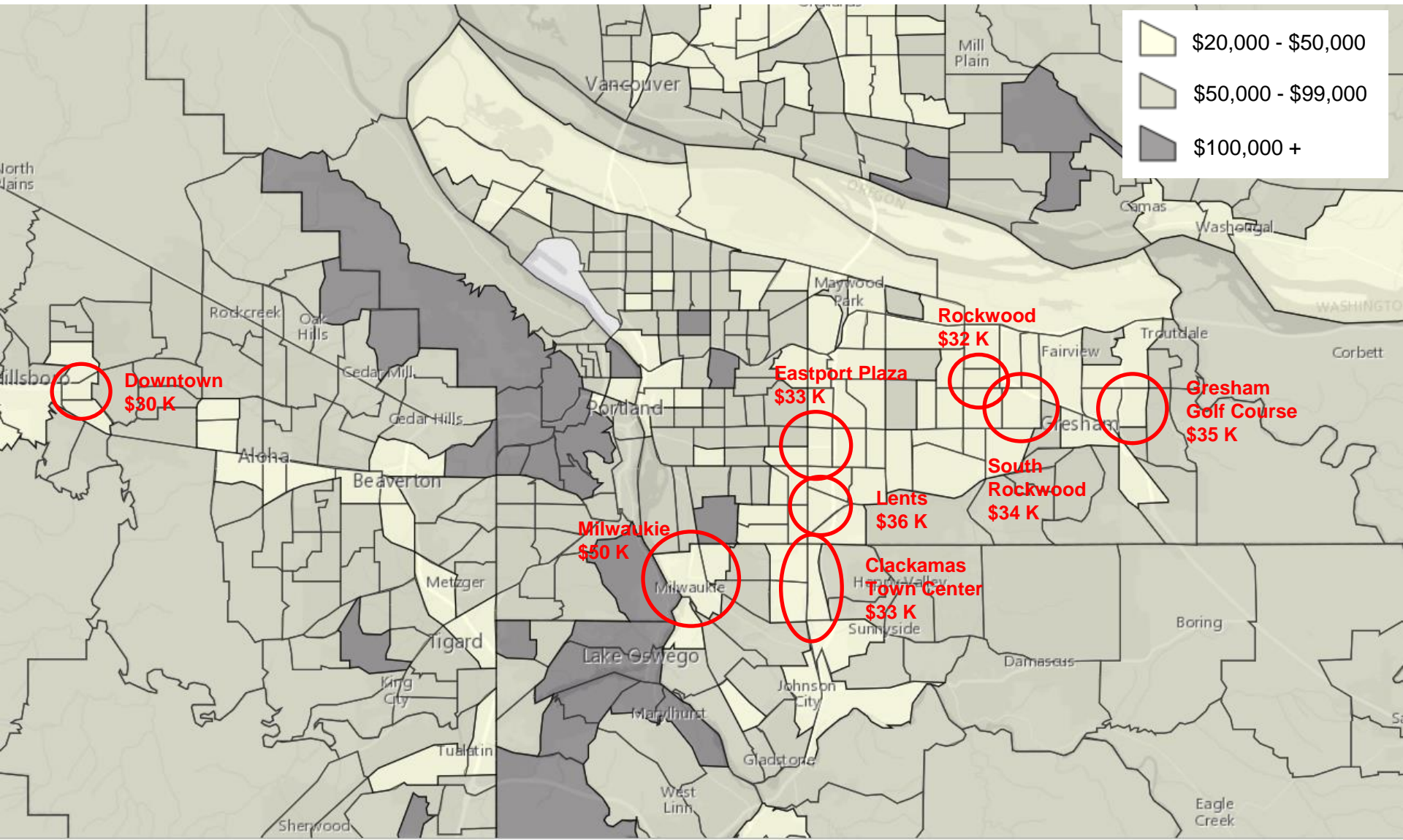
Average Income by Census Tract - 2014



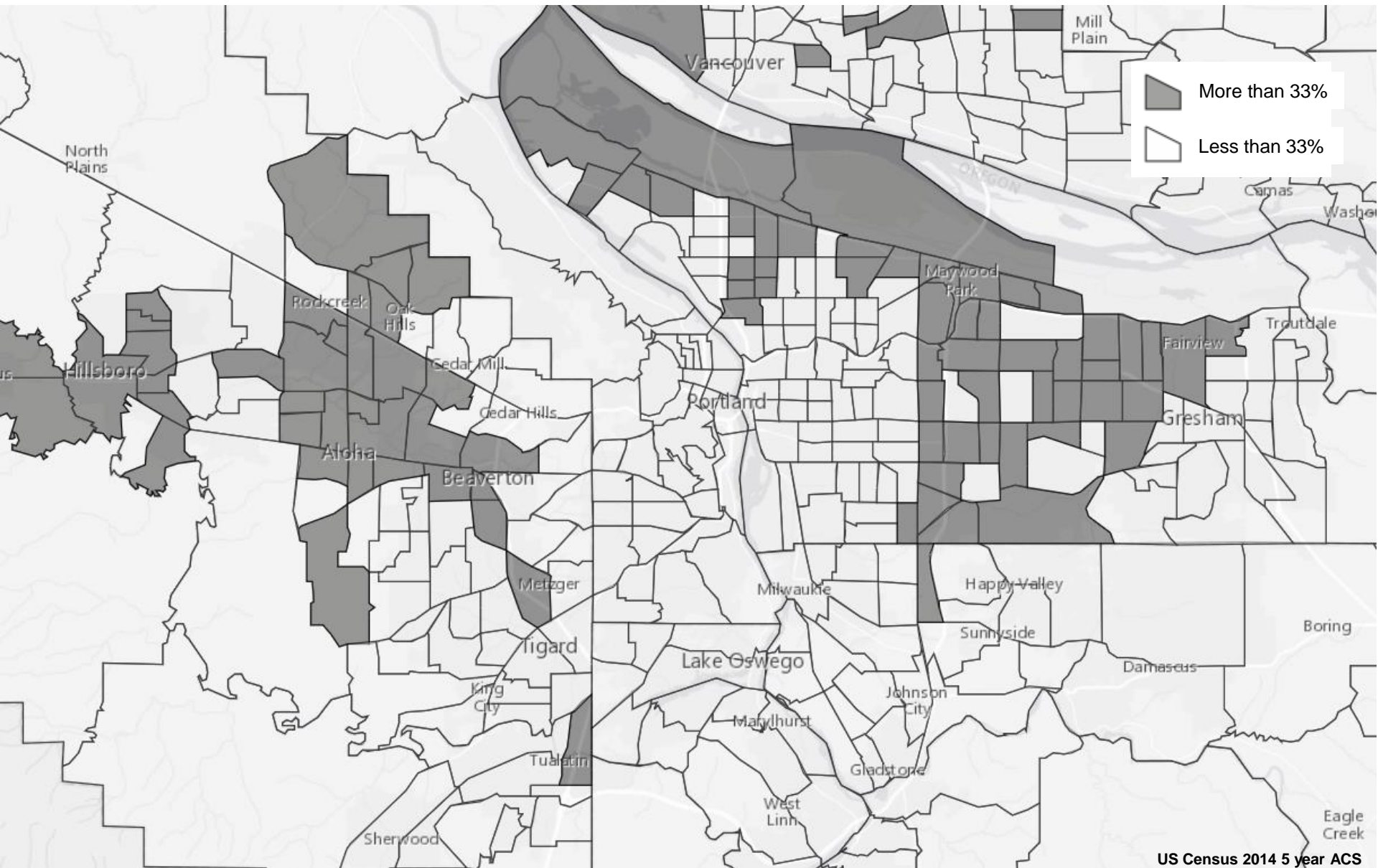

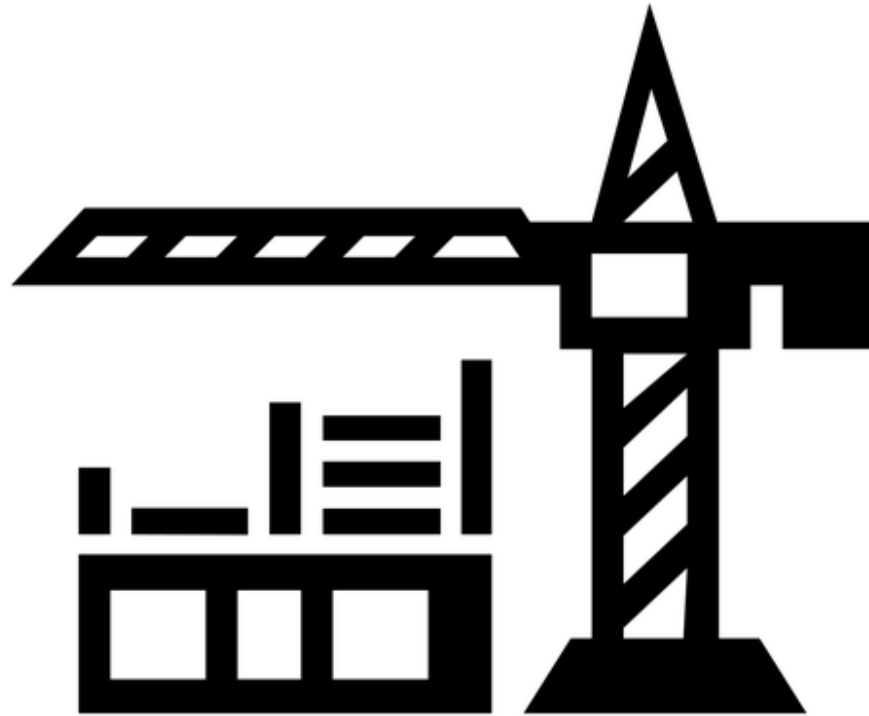

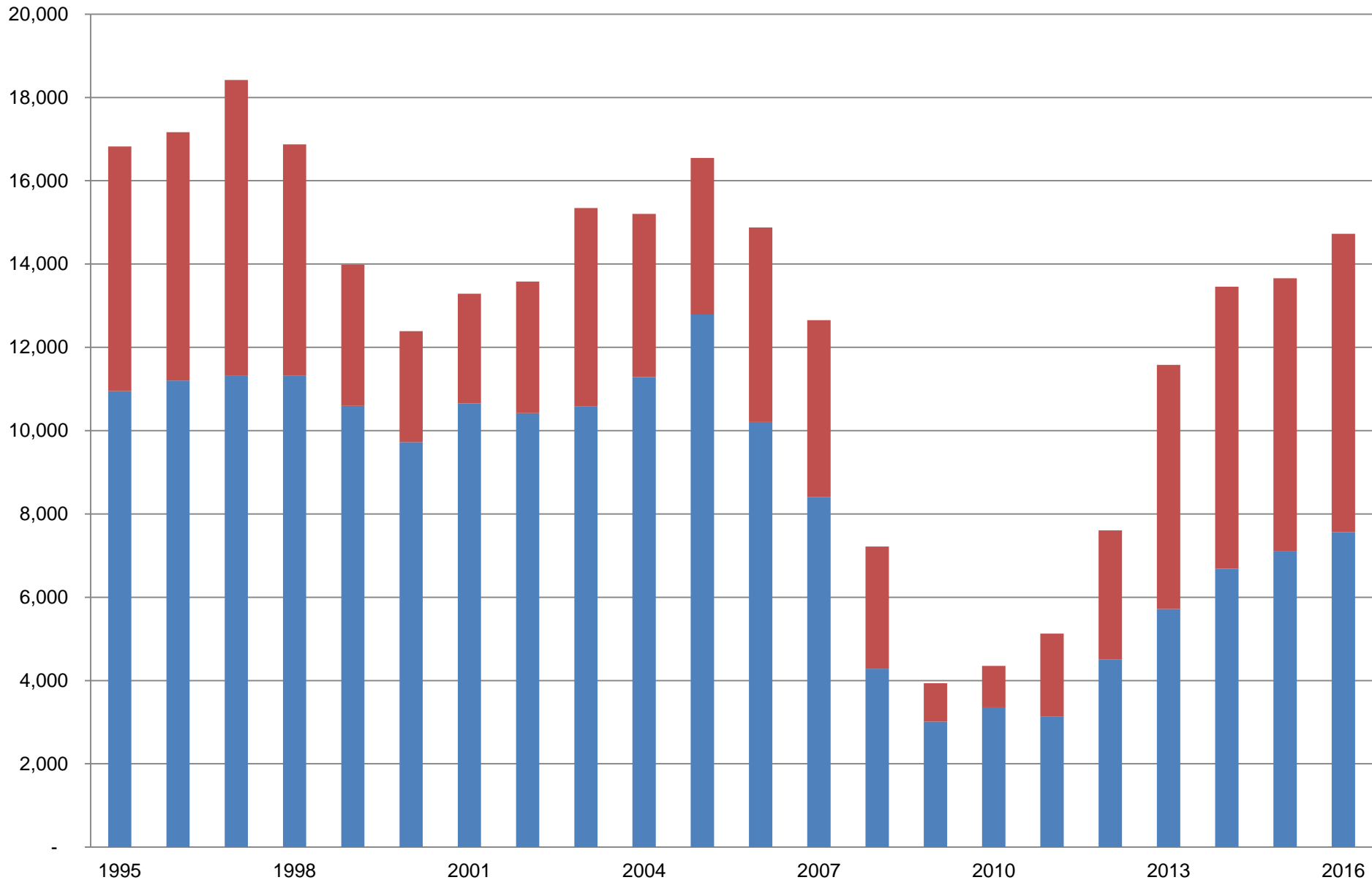
