The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:


- a. A broad coalition of local organizations and individuals has come together to sponsor Expressions of Human Dignity Month, an explosion of cultural events including:
- The exhibit, "*Anne Frank: A History for Today*" at Lloyd Center;
 - The film, *Journey to a Hate Free Millennium*, addressing the terrible deaths of Matthew Shepard and James Byrd, Jr.;
 - An Oregon Symphony concert, *The Defiant Requiem: Verdi at Terezin*, featuring music performed at the Jewish ghetto town of Terezin in Czechoslovakia in the shadow of the Holocaust;
 - and many other events designed to cause our citizens to reflect on, and ponder how to combat, the forces of intolerance and discrimination . . . but also to celebrate the dignity and tenacity of the human spirit.
