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- Projects – FY2011 and beyond
 - Organizational (cont.)
 - Business Process Reengineering – other areas
 - Contracts System Redesign
 - FY10 goal: 20% of recommendations implemented
 - FY10 actual: 37% implementation rate
 - Electronic processing & storage – went live 4/1/10
 - Administrative Infrastructure

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- Long Term Issues & Challenges
 - Financial
 - Ability to maintain reserves at policy level
 - Ability to maintain County's bond rating
 - Management of long term liabilities
 - PERS
 - Health care – active employees & retirees
 - Capital Maintenance
 - Debt Obligations



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- Long Term Issues & Challenges
 - Operational
 - Ability to meet numerous external requirements
 - Indirect cost methodology
 - Sellwood Bridge – securing funding



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- Long Term Issues & Challenges
 - Technology
 - Budget System sorely needed
 - Internal Services
 - Morrison Bridgehead property – impact to fleet & revenue
 - Implementation of Climate Action Plan goals
