Hello Commissioners, I respectfully request reconsideration of the following action items which is the

counties river communities contribution to helping reduce homelessness and providing affordable housing to the Metro areas families. This is not new evidence into the record.

* Allow the rural county moorages to infill the empty dock slips/spaces within existing permitted DSL (Division of State Lands) Water Way Lease footprints. This would not increase or detract from existing landscape features along the river.

* Providing the moorage has the capacity for increased sewer, water and power utility connections, permit the approved moorages to allow boats to be lived on for extended stay and not be counted as permanent residences against the counties "Policy 26" which established the one (1) houseboat per each fifty (50) feet of upland water frontage. A comprehensive list of more detailed moorage requirements was compiled and submitted to The County Planning Department in 2016.

* Permit RV hook ups on moorage Communities upland property for extended stay that have the ability to increase capacity for sewer, water and power utilities.
