ORDINANCE NO. 304

WHEREAS, the Corrections Classification System Advisory Commission reported its recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners on March 16, 1982; and

WHEREAS, Recommendation XI encourages elected officials to establish a public information/education campaign to enlighten the public about critical issues and policy choices facing the justice system; and

WHEREAS, it is determined that an informed public policy debate is best accomplished through the auspices of organizations whose charters include public education on policy issues;

NOW, THEREFORE, Multnomah County ordains as follows:

The County shall support the development of symposia, conferences and other public events by neutral organizations, and invite elected and appointed officials to fully participate in such events.

This ordinance remains in effect for a period of nine months from the operative date.
