WHEREAS, the federal government enacted the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 requiring the development of a Comprehensive Housing Affordability Strategy (CHAS) by jurisdictions that wish to be eligible for Community Development block Grants and certain federal housing programs; and

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of the Cities of Portland, Gresham, Multnomah County, and the other cities of Multnomah County have approved the development of a joint and coordinated strategy; and

WHEREAS, after an extensive citizen involvement process, the CHAS Steering Committee voted on October 30, 1991, to recommend adoption of the CHAS (incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A) and an Addendum of Revisions (incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit B) by the Cities of Portland, Gresham, and Multnomah County; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to begin immediately to develop a recommended structure of the Housing and Community Development Commission for consideration by the elected bodies of Portland, Gresham, and Multnomah County;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board adopt the recommended Countywide Housing Affordability Strategy (Exhibits A and B); and

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County represent County issues and resources on the interjurisdictional transition team to refine the CHAS First Year Action Plan and to draft implementing ordinances to be brought before the Board by March 1, 1992.
