WHEREAS, the City of Portland filed an annexation proposal (No. 2686) with the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission approved the proposal on October 19, 1989; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 199.505(1), electors filed a remonstrance petition with the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission; and

WHEREAS, on January 17, 1990, the Director of Elections of Multnomah County certified to the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission that the number of valid signatures on the remonstrance exceeded 10 percent of the registered electors in the affected territory; and

WHEREAS, ORS 199.505(3) requires that upon receipt of the certification of signatures on a remonstrance petition, the Board of County Commissioners shall call an election, to be held on the next appropriate election date authorized by law;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that an election is hereby called to be held on March 27, 1990, at which the following measure shall be submitted to the electors in the affected territory:

CAPTION

Proposal to annex certain territory to the City of Portland.

QUESTION

Shall the area indicated on the Attached Map (Annexation Proposal 2686) be annexed to the City of Portland?

EXPLANATION

The Metropolitan Area Local Boundary Commission has approved annexation proposal 2686. Under that proposal, the territory shown on the map accompanying this ballot would be annexed to the City of Portland. A petition objecting to the annexation has been filed. An election by the voters in the territory to be annexed is therefore required. A "yes" vote is in favor of the annexation. A "no" vote is against the annexation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following summary of the measure shall appear in the voters pamphlet for the March 27, 1990 election:

The Metropolitan Area Local Boundary Commission has approved annexation proposal 2686. Under that proposal, the territory shown on the map accompanying this ballot would be annexed to the City of Portland. A petition objecting to the annexation has been filed. An election by the voters in the territory to be annexed is therefore required. A "yes" vote is in favor of the annexation. A "no" vote is against the annexation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Board shall forthwith deliver certified copies of this resolution to the Director of Elections, the City Auditor of the City of Portland, and the Executive Officer of the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission.


