

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
FOR MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON  
ORDINANCE NO. 361

An Ordinance establishing a regular plenary session for elected officials in Multnomah County.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Policy and Purpose. The Board of County Commissioners finds there is a need to provide for a system for regular communication among elected and appointed officials in Multnomah County government regarding legislative, financial matters and policy issues.

SECTION 2. Plenary Committee. The Plenary Committee is established as a committee of Multnomah County government.

SECTION 3. Membership and Staff.

A. The Committee shall consist of the twelve (12) elected officials:

- (1) The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners;
- (2) The County Executive;
- (3) The County Sheriff;
- (4) The District Attorney;

- (5) The Multnomah County Auditor;
  - (6) The County Clerk;
  - (7) The County Tax Assessor;
  - (8) The Clerk of the District Court;
- (B) A member of the Board of County Commissioners as designated by the Presiding Officer shall act as the Chair of the Plenary Committee.
- (C) The Committee shall be supported by a Plenary Coordinator and the staff of the member of the Board designated as the Chair of the Plenary Committee.
- (D) A quorum of the Plenary Committee shall consist of 7 officials, three of which shall be other than members of the Board.

SECTION 4. Powers and Duties of the Committee.

- (A) The Committee shall meet at least once each quarter in order to discuss legislative, financial matters, and policy issues.
- (B) The Committee shall advise the Board of County Commissioners on all matters it has discussed.
- (C) The Committee may be called together for the purpose of dis-

cussing issues on an emergency basis.

(D) Meetings of the Plenary Committee may be called by the Chair or any three members of the Committee.


