RESOLUTION NO. 00-168

Establishing Support for the Alliance of Latino Parents for Better Schools Leaders' Assembly

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- A. The Alliance of Latino Parents for Better Schools and the administration of the Reynolds School District seek to promote greater access to bilingual/bicultural educational opportunities for Latino youth, decrease the drop-out rate among Latino youth, encourage higher education for Latino youth, and develop parental and community leadership in co-operation with schools.
- B. The Alliance of Latino Parents for and the Reynolds School District are holding a Leaders' Assembly on Thursday, November 2, 2000 at 7:00 P.M. at Reynolds High School, at which time they will pursue further discussion and implementation of the themes listed above.
- C. Supporting the efforts of the Alliance of Latino Parents for Better Schools, in co-operation with the administration of Reynolds School District is consistent with the first long-term Benchmark listed in the County's adopted 2000-01 budget of Increasing School Success.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

- 1. The County will support the efforts of the Alliance of Latino Parents for Better Schools in co-operation with the Reynolds School District.
- 2. The County recognizes that they have been invited to attend the Leaders' Assembly on Thursday, November 2, 2000.
