WHEREAS, Multnomah County recognizes the dual purpose of the National Scenic Area Act (to protect the environment and promote the economy in the N.S.A.) that impacts the lives of citizens living in the National Scenic Area; and

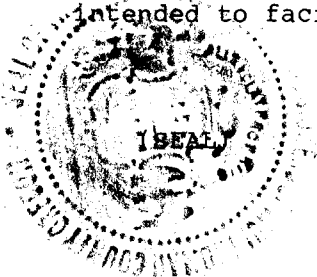
WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners considers Public Involvement an important component to seek input into the Final Management Plan; and,

WHEREAS, Elaine Cogan, (Cogan, Sharpe and Cogan, Public Relations Consultants on contract to the Columbia Gorge Bi-State Commission), has designed a public involvement program that asks for cooperation between Multnomah County and the Columbia Gorge Bi-State Commission; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, Multnomah County hereby endorses the cooperation between the county and the Columbia Gorge Bi-State Commission in its public involvement process, and,

BE IT RESOLVED THAT, The county must amend zoning ordinances to comply and implement the Final Management Plan; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, A joint meeting will be held in Corbett on Thursday, October 20, 1988, including a regular Multnomah County Board of Commissioners meeting at 9:30 AM; and a "Community Fair" to be held in the afternoon intended to facilitate public involvement.
