The above entitled matter is before the Board of County Commissioners, acting in its capacity as the Multnomah County Public Contract Review Board, to review, pursuant to ORS 279.055(3) and AR 10.110, a declaration of emergency for replacement by purchase of used pumper fire engine vehicle from Western States Fire Apparatus, Inc., in the amount of \$38,500.

It appearing to the Board that the declaration of emergency, as it appears in this order is based upon the fact that the current pumper fire engine vehicle used to serve the West Station of the Skyline Fire District (Multnomah County Fire District No. 20) is no longer operational or feasible for repair. The fire district does not have the budget funds to purchase a new vehicle, therefore, efforts were made throughout the State of Oregon to purchase a used vehicle within the budget constraints. A used vehicle became available through trade-in from another fire district and Western States Fire Apparatus, Inc., has agreed to sell the vehicle for \$38,500.

It appearing to the Board that the declaration of emergency is in accord with the requirements of the Multnomah County Public Contract Review Board Administrative Rules AR 10.100, and ORS 279.055(3), therefore

ORDERED that the pumper fire engine vehicle be exempted from the requirement of public bidding.




