General Information

1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

The Department of County Management recommends approving an updated Resolution defining the funds to be used in FY 2012 and repealing Resolution 2011-073.

2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results.

Each year the Board is asked to ratify the fund structure by which the County does its accounting. The Resolution lists all the funds in place as of July 1, segregates them by fund type, and briefly describes the revenues and expenditures for which each fund accounts. The fund structure follows generally accepted accounting principles and is consistent with the budget document.

The House Bill 3188, which was passed during the 2011 Regular Session, requires Video Lottery revenues and expenditures to be accounted for in a separate fund. This new Resolution is updated to include a new Video Lottery Fund as follows:

Video Lottery Fund (1519) – Accounts for revenues received from the Oregon State Lottery. Expenditures are restricted to furthering economic development per House Bill 3188 passed during the 2011 Regular Session of the 76th Oregon Legislative Assembly.
