My name is Vicki Tracey, and I attended the September 29th meeting and spoke to you regarding the feeding of animals. I explained the situation in my neighborhood, which entails a person who puts peanuts (another neighbor spent \$1100.

at the vet because their two dogs had peanut shells lodged in their digestive tract), birdseed, bread crumbs and bread all over the ground DAILY. This has not only caused the squirrel population to increase exponentially, but it has brought rats out of the sewers and into our yards. I stood and watched rats coming out from behind his garage to eat the food he scatters every day, and his backyard neighbor found a rat behind her stove and a rat nest in her shed.

As I explained at the meeting, I have tried every possible angle to make him understand that he is creating a terrible nuisance and a possible health issue. I wrote a letter (I gave a copy to you at the meeting) which 20 neighbors signed, asking him to please stop feeding these animals. Not only did he continue feeding, but has actually increased the amounts.

Your assistant told me I should contact the Neighborhood Mediation folks, which I did, and I spoke with Justine. She called and left several messages, then finally wrote a letter asking him to please respond. There was no response on either count.

I am at a loss now, and am asking you to please push an ordinance through that would require him to stop this behavior. I'm quite sure mine is not the only neighborhood with this problem.

Rat Infestation

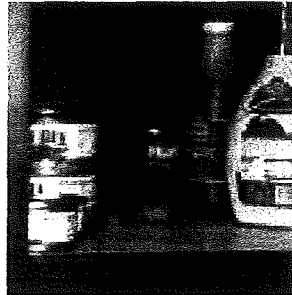


Rat on Countertop

Rats are responsible for the transmission of many diseases. Their feeding habits are destructive, and their nesting behaviors can compromise the structure of infested buildings. However, rats are secretive and not seen by humans when populations are low. Therefore, an infestation may prove difficult to confirm. The most obvious sign of a rat infestation is the presence of dead or living rats. Rats prefer to hide, given enough space, so if rats are observed in plain sight, it is likely that a full-blown infestation already exists. When space becomes limited due to increased population, rats are forced out into the open. Rat droppings may be present, indicating a healthy, feeding rat population. Rats also tend to leave dirt or

grease marks along walls and floorboards.

If these obvious signs are not present, examine the surroundings for rat runs. These tracks are left in grass and low vegetation and act as foraging paths for rodents. Rats tend to follow the same paths after they have been established. Norway rats dwell in burrows found in grassy embankments, beneath the roots of trees and at the edges of paving and drain covers. Roof rat nests may also be found inside in lofts, attics, beneath floorboards and in other dark, infrequently visited locations.

Rats gnaw incessantly on materials such as plastic and wood. The presence of damaged materials and large holes in floorboards and walls are sure signs of infestation. Rat teeth marks are large and rough in appearance.

In the event of an infestation, it is best to consult a pest control professional. Although various traps are available, they address only individual specimens and will not prove effective in the face of an infestation. Additionally, rats tend to be wary of unknown objects in their established foraging paths.

Diseases Directly Transmitted by Rats

- **Hantavirus Pulmonary Syndrome.** This is a viral disease that is transmitted by the rice rat. This disease is spread in one of three ways: inhaling dust that is contaminated with rat urine or droppings, direct contact with rat feces or urine, and infrequently due to the bite of rat.
- **Leptospirosis.** This is a bacterial disease that can be transmitted by coming into contact with infected water by swimming, wading or kayaking or by contaminated drinking water. Individuals may be at increased risk of Leptospirosis infections if they work outdoors or with animals.
- **Rat-bite Fever.** This disease may be transmitted through a bite, scratch or contact with a dead rat.

Salmonellosis. Consuming food or water that is contaminated by rat feces bacteria can cause this disease.

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



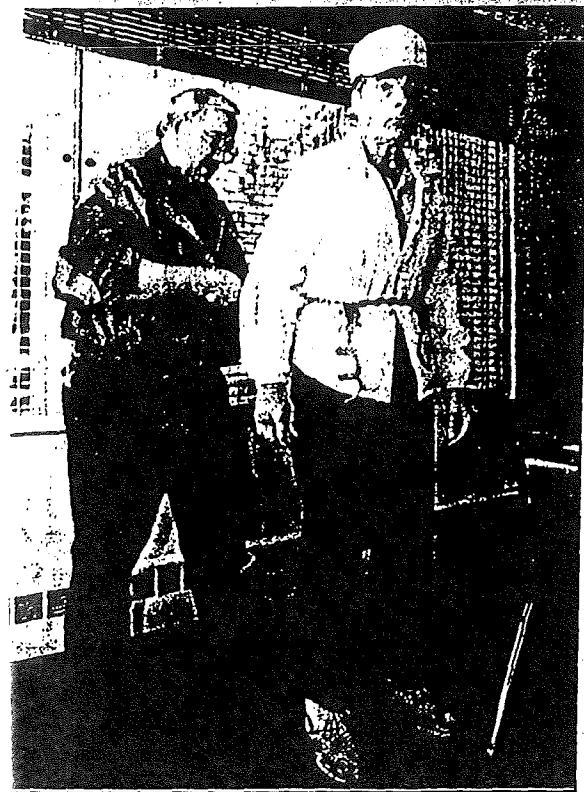

A question of credibility

■ A former prosecutor's pursuit of criminals lands him in a psychiatric ward.

Twenty years ago, Roger Weidner was putting criminals behind bars. He was chief prosecutor in the consumer fraud department of the Multnomah County district attorney's office.

Today, he's locked up in a Salem psychiatric ward with killers and thieves.

Weidner, 57, is undergoing court-ordered psychiatric evaluation in the Oregon State Hospital's forensic program for the criminally insane.

His supporters say he's a tenacious whistle-blower who's paying a steep price for waging a noisy, oddball campaign against the legal establishment.

On the other hand, he just might be crazy.

In August, a Multnomah County judge ordered Wei-

dner into the state hospital for a check of his mental condition.

It was the fed-up legal system's response to the prosecutor's unrelenting — some say reckless — campaign to expose corrupt lawyers and judges.

Crazy or not, Weidner has battled the system for years.

Typically, he steams into court with a cadre of supporters, demands to "make a record" of his charges and points accusing fingers at judges who turn a deaf ear to his tirades.

Judges respond by re-treating to their chambers or finding Weidner in contempt of court. In all, he has been arrested more than a dozen times.

Contending that he was railroaded into the psychiatric unit for speaking out,

Weidner is seeking a Marion County court hearing to plead for his freedom.

"I'm a political prisoner in this place," he declared.

A check of Weidner's medical file revealed little about his mental condition. However, at least one psychiatrist has told Weidner that he's delusional. In psychiatric terms, that means Weidner holds firm beliefs in spite of strong evidence indicating they are false.

Weidner scoffed at the diagnosis: "I'm a far cry from being delusional. I have no belief or opinion that is not based on fact."

Habeas Corpus Granted – Weidner Released

Judge Baker Lies In Hearing: "I Committed Weidner For His Own Good"

Roger Weidner has spent the last seven years of his life trying to ring about an investigation into provable corruption in the Oregon courts that would allow the theft of a \$multi-million estate. The deeper Weidner has investigated, the more attorneys, judges and other evil servants are implicated in the bizarre story of the vanished Littleberg estate.

The closer Weidner gets to getting the provably guilty players into court, the more severe the repercussions against him. To keep Weidner and his mountain of evidence out of the courtroom, he has been thrown in jail 14 times.

An obvious move to shut him up for good, Judge Baker committed Weidner to the maximum security facility at the state mental hospital July 25, where he was subjected to "The CooCoo's Nest" and the administrations of professionals who make a living keeping people here. Roger Weidner was released from his involuntary incarceration at the Oregon State Mental Hospital Oct. 16, but remanded to Multnomah County "Justice" Center until his Oct. 20 hearing in Judge Dorothy Baker's court. The hearing was scheduled to decide Weidner's immediate future regarding the contempt of court charges which prompted his court ordered committal

Weidner's two-month stay in the insane asylum was ordered by Judge Baker July 25, 1995, to supposedly determine if Weidner was able to aid and assist in his own defense of contempt of court charges.

The contempt charges were issued after Weidner's repeated attempts to make a court record of PROVABLE evidence of corruption in the Oregon judicial system. Weidner's evidence

This remote Eastern Oregon County has been boiling like a caldron for the last nine months. Ever since a courageous little group of citizens formed the Enuf is Enuf committee and tried to break the stranglehold that County Judge Dale White and his gang have held them in for decades, things have been cooking. Since the recall failed, the "gang" has been seeking retribution.

An attempted recall of Judge Dale White and commissioner Lee Wallace

was a close race, especially when you consider the ballots which weren't sent to some voters in Phil Kiesling's vote by mail recall election and the barrage of LIES which echoed from the mouth of Stan Swol over KZZR radio. Initiative to Break Legal Monopoly Of Oregon State Bar Now Available

The initiative would amend the Oregon Constitution to create an independent, elected Oregon Judicial Council. It would license and regulate attorneys, judges, and paralegals, hear and investigate complaints against them, and have authority to take appropriate disciplinary action.

Why an "Oregon Judicial Council"?

Dal Ferry, President of the Oregon Institute for Justice (OIJ), states that court watchers, observers, and others have reported that all too often justice is perverted by unethical attorneys who bleed client trust fund accounts dry with exorbitant fees, bill for work not done and other unethical or questionable practices.

He states he has received numerous

reports of judges who do not abide by the Oregon judicial code and Canons by refusing to remove themselves from cases where they may be prejudiced or have a conflict of interest, have exhibited abusive behavior toward those appearing in their court, have rendered obviously predetermined rulings apparently without considering the evidence and being intoxicated and falling asleep while presiding in court.

"Oversight of attorneys and judges by other attorneys belonging to the Oregon State Bar is a clear conflict of interest," said Art Thompson, one of the

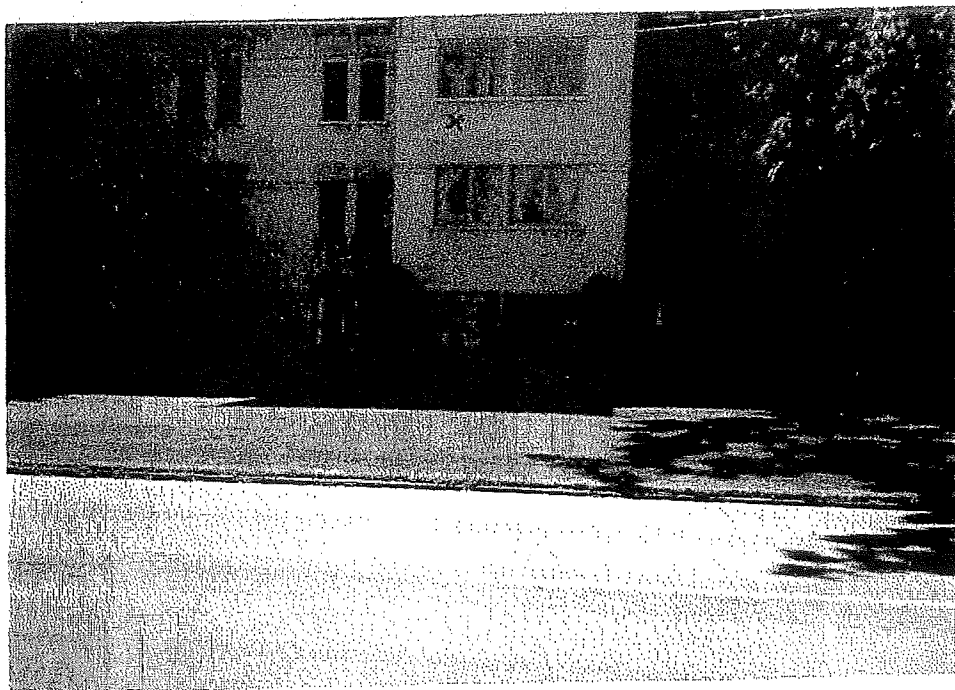



PREPARED STATEMENT HOUSE-SENATE HEARING JANUARY 26, 2000

My name is Roger Weidner. I was the 1998 Reform Party candidate for Governor of Oregon. I am a former attorney and public prosecutor. In 1975-76 I ran the Consumer Fraud Department in the Multnomah County District Attorneys Office.

For the past 12 years I have been engaged full time in trying to recover for my client Janette Kent the 100 million dollar Don Kettleberg estate that was awarded to her in 1988 by then Judge Charles Crookham. The order, signed by Judge Crookham, requiring that the Kettleberg estate assets be turned over to her "forth with" was intentionally withheld from her by her trial attorney. We know now that terminally ill Kettleberg's premature death was caused by his two partners, attorney Milton Brown and Dr. Charles Hahn, writing "do not resuscitate" on his medical records. After Kettleberg's death Brown and Hahn forged fourteen corporate Fourteen converting all Kettleberg estate assets.

In addition to assisting Janette Kent I have also, during the past twelve years, been involved in helping numerous other innocent people, who have had either their property or children wrongfully taken from by either corrupt attorneys, bureaucrats or judges.

The core problem, in all cases, is that these innocent people have not been able to get the facts in their particular case before a jury of their peers as the law provides. The cases are either dismissed by the judge, on one pretense or another, or if there is a hearing it is a sham, with the outcome is a forgone conclusion, and the innocent person always losing.

What has happened in our courts today, is that the sovereign citizens of this state are being systematically denied their rights to "due process" of law and "equal protection of law" guaranteed to them under the 5th and 14th Amendments to the United States Constitution, and Article 1 Sections 1 and 10 of the Oregon Constitution. Article 1 Section 1 of the Oregon Constitution provides:

We declare that all men, when they form a social compact are equal in right: that all power is inherent in the people, and all free governments are founded on their authority, and instituted for their peace, safety, and happiness; and they have at all times a right to alter, reform, or abolish the government in such manner as they may think proper.

Article 1 Section 10 of the Oregon Constitution provides:

No court shall be secret, but justice shall be administered, openly and without purchase, completely and without delay, and every man shall have remedy by due course of law for injury done him in his person, property, or reputation.

Our state government, under Article 111 Section 1 of the Oregon Constitution, consists of three co-equal branches of government, Executive, Legislative and Judicial. Each branch acts as a check and balance on the other branches. That constitutionally mandated form of government has been fundamentally altered here in Oregon. The trial courts in this state have ceased being a part of a co-equal branch of government and have become administrative tribunals. They enforce, without questioning administrative orders or laws passed by the legislature. Any citizen who questions the constitutionality of either the administrative order or statute are told by the judge to either go to the



Weidner publicly condemns Gladstone Police Chief King

The Oregon Observer in its May-June, 2001, edition related the story of Roger Weidner, on June 6, 2001, arresting Milton Brown for the murder of his former business partner Donald Kettleberg and the theft of Kettleberg's property that today is worth 100 million dollars. We also reported that when Weidner, with supporters Lou Sutton, Bob Shannon and Richard Burdett, reported to Gladstone Police Chief Robert King, that he had been threatened with arrest by Gladstone Police Sergeant Johnson prior to arresting Brown, he was also threatened by King. Weidner then sent the following letter to Chief King and made arrangements to appear before the Gladstone City Council on June 11, 2001.—

Chief King,

As you are aware I am a former attorney and public prosecutor who, for the past 13 1/2 years, has been attempting to recover for my client Janette Kent the Don Kettleberg estate that is today worth 100 million dollars. All of the assets of the Kettleberg estate were stolen by Kettleberg business partners, disbarred attorney Milton Brown and Dr. Charles Hahn with the aid of a corrupt group of Oregon attorneys and judges. For attempting to recover the stolen property and expose the corruption I have been ruthlessly persecuted, for the past 13 years by the Oregon State Bar and that corrupt group of judges in the Oregon judicial system. That persecution has involved repeated sham prosecutions and jailings for a total of 290 days. While jailed I was subjected to forced blood draws and forced medical examinations while shackled hand and foot.

Several months ago I dropped by

your office to inform you that I, along with Jesse Lott had taken back one of the stolen Kettleberg properties, Tri-City Mobil Home Park, located in Gladstone, Oregon. You sat quiet and did not question the truthfulness of any of the criminal charges I was making against Brown, and those involved with him, in stealing all the Kettleberg estate assets.

On June 6, 2001, I called the Clackamas County Sheriff's office to advise them that Milton Brown was on the property at Tri-City Mobil Home Park and that I was going to arrest him for murder, theft, forgery and conspiracy. I was told to call 911. Shortly after my call Sergeant Wayne Johnson and officer Voss with your department appeared on the scene. I told Johnson that I intended to arrest Brown and I simply wanted him to stand by to insure the arrest would be orderly. Instead of complying with my request Johnson became threatening, saying he would arrest me if I tried to arrest Brown. I told Johnson that I was a former prosecutor and that I was not asking for his advice or threats and expected him not to interfere in the arrest.

I then approached Brown and held him by the arm while I told him I was arresting him for the murder of Kettleberg and the theft of all Kettleberg estate assets. Brown was momentarily stunned then started yelling "You stay away from me! You stay away from me," as he pulled away from me and hid behind Johnson. Shortly after the arrest I along with Lou Sutton, Bob Shannon and Richard Burdett went to your office to report that Johnson had unlawfully threatened me with arrest and attempted to interfere in my arrest of Brown.

I, along with my three supporters were stunned by your rude, hostile and

threatening behavior. You would not allow me to explain that all the criminal information I had recently submitted to you, about the criminal conduct of Brown in stealing all Kettleberg estate assets, had been repeatedly testified to, by me and others, in court, without question or objection by Brown or those assisting him in the theft of all Kettleberg estate assets. Instead you rudely interrupted me and said all the information I had submitted to you "was a bunch of crap" that you threw in the garbage can. When I attempted to explain that the evidence had never been denied or challenged in or out of court you had the unmitigated gall to say, with Johnson standing by your side in a threatening posture, "You are full of shit Weidner." Further you had the stupidity to say it in front of three witnesses. If I didn't tell you then King I meant to say that you are obviously corrupt and in the pocket of Milton Brown to conduct yourself, as a public official and employee in such a shameful, outrageous and contemptible manner. You, by your behavior, have certainly demonstrated to at least four citizens of this state, that you are totally unfit to serve on the public payroll as any kind of public official, particularly as a police chief. Further I want you to know I will do everything in my power to see that you are permanently removed from the public payroll and replaced with a person who takes serious his oath of office to protect and defend the constitutional rights of all citizens. With Sincerity Roger Weidner

P.S. To: Mayor Byers and all members of the Gladstone City Council—Would you all please see that Chief King and Sergeant Johnson attend the June 11th City Council meeting scheduled for 6:30 pm in the Gladstone City Hall. On June 11, 2001 Weidner appeared before

the Gladstone City Council with supporters, including political activist Jesse Lott, former Oregon State Treasurer candidate Carlos Lucero, former Marion County Sheriff Jack Utterback and his wife Dixie, Lou Sutton, Dee Porte and many other concerned citizens. Chief King, as requested by Weidner also appeared.

Weidner from the podium publicly condemned King for his earlier hostile and threatening behavior. Weidner, pointing at King, said "the citizens of this state will not tolerate their public employee police officers to threaten innocent citizens who report criminal behavior and then give armed guard protection to the thieves." He said King, like all the members of the Council, were sworn public official who have all taken an oath of office to uphold and defend the constitutions of the State of Oregon and the United States of America, against all enemies foreign and domestic. Weidner said those attorneys and judges who have so shamelessly violated their oath of office, and subverted our rule of law, by their involvement in systematically stealing innocent peoples property are most certainly domestic enemies whose criminal behavior threatens the safety of all citizens.

King sat alone, red-faced in the middle of Weidner's supporters, while being condemned by Weidner. As Weidner's supporters were leaving the hearing room Frances Weidner, Roger's 91 year old mother, walked up to King and with contempt said, "you should be ashamed of yourself." King did not respond, but his red face took on a purple hue after Frances Weidner finished with him.

Editors note: I guess that citizens arrests (always a valid method of arrest) are no longer valid. Hmmm.

An Open Letter to Attorney General John Ashcroft

Dear General Ashcroft,

I am a former attorney and public prosecutor who for the past 13½ years has been waging a campaign, along with thousands of other Oregonians, against the widespread corruption in the Oregon Court systems. It was the 1998 Oregon Reform Party candidate for governor and am currently Vice-president of Oregon Judicial Watch, a 1,000 member group of concerned citizens determined to restore constitutional government to the citizens of Oregon. Through the internet and *The Oregon Observer* we are connected with hundreds, perhaps thousands, of other like-minded citizen groups around the country that have formed in the past 10 years to restore constitutional government to the citizens of this country.

I have had the help of many, including political activist Jesse Lott, in fighting the corruption problem here in Oregon. Jesse met with you on his last trip to Washington D.C. I am enclosing the picture of you and he together that appeared on the front page of *The Oregon Observer*. Also on the front page of that paper is a my picture taken in Judge Ellen Rosenbloom's courtroom on February 21, 2001. During that hearing I gave undisputed, sworn testimony of the criminal conduct of the attorneys and judges involved in the corruption I have been fighting for the last 13½ years. That testimony appears on the backside of the article containing our pictures.

I am also enclosing an open letter, describing the corruption here in Oregon, that my mother Frances Weidner sent to President Gordon Hinckley of the Mormon Church and to Utah Senator Orin Hatch and Oregon Senator Gordon Smith, both

Mormons. A copy also was sent to Michael Mossman the new U.S. Attorney for Oregon who is also a Mormon.

I am also enclosing for your review a letter I sent in December of 1998, to Supreme Court Justice Clarence Thomas describing the corruption problem. Also enclosed is a story appearing in THE SPOTLIGHT describing the abuse I have endured for exposing the judicial corruption here in Oregon. On the back page of that story is the article describing my confrontation with Oregon Supreme Court Chief Justice Wallace Carson, about the judicial corruption in the Oregon court system, that took place outside a hearing room in the Oregon State Capitol.

I know you are presently consumed by the tragic terrorist attacks on this country of September 11, 2001. However General Ashcroft there is a domestic enemy loose in this great land, terrorizing innocent citizens who poses a threat to the American way of life equal to if not greater than that posed by foreign enemies. That domestic enemy, the one Thomas Jefferson warned against, is the tyranny of a corrupt judiciary.

I have been the subject of numerous arrests, some violent, twice, where I thought my life was going to be taken for attempting to speak in court on the record about this corruption. I have been jailed a total of 290 days and subjected to forced medical examinations while shackled hand and foot. I believe that the only reason that I am alive today, and able to write to you about this most dangerous situation, is because of the large number of people who have been supporting our fight against this corruption. This is a fight we cannot

and will not lose.

I heard both you and President Bush say that you will use the full force of our government to bring those foreign terrorists to justice for the crimes they have committed against humanity and this great Nation. So also, must you General Ashcroft and President Bush, to restore integrity to our judicial system and public confidence in our institutions of government, use your great offices, with the support of the tens of thousands of us in the Patriot community, to bring these domestic enemies (corrupt, tyrannical judges and public officials) to justice.

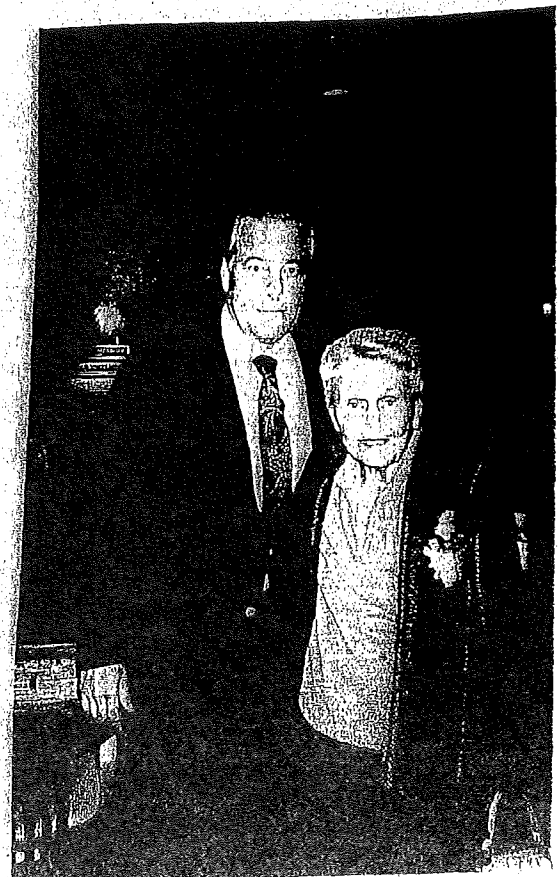

Enclosed are my letters to public officials and documents and newspaper stories, published over the past 15 years, detailing the unprecedented criminal abuse I and other citizens of Oregon have suffered, and continue to suffer, for attempting to expose in court, on the record, under oath, the criminal conduct of bureaucrats and attorneys, some judges, involved in stealing citizens children, lands and other property in "sham" often "star chamber" type proceedings. Instead of the citizens being allowed to make a record in court of their injuries, as the constitution requires, these innocent citizen, myself and Patricia Wishon and others included, have been either threatened with arrest or arrested when we try to speak on the record about that victimization. At the same time what I have personally witnessed are these same corrupt attorneys and judges, involved in this scandalous and shameful behavior, being given armed escort service, by Sheriff deputies, in and out of the courthouse to protect them from their angry victims who are being threatened, maced, arrested, beaten-up, jailed and thrown into the insane asylum, as I have been, for insisting on making a public record, something each citizen has an absolute right to do, about our victimization. For the last 5 years the focus of my work, fighting the corruption in the Oregon court system, has been in Deschutes County Oregon. A clear picture of the abuse Wishon, myself and others have been subjected to by attorneys, judges and Sheriff personnel for exposing the corruption can be had by reviewing the following documents:




